 ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA, APRIL, 1934.
Asbestos production in Canada during April amounted to 10,611 tons, in the preceding month 12,629 tons were produced and in April, 1933, the output was 8,322 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa.

Canada exported 9,280 tons of asbestos in April as compared with 13,377 tons
in March. Seventy-eight per cent of the April exports were consigned to the United Statas.
disbestos products imported into Canada in fpril were valucd at $\ddagger 46,572$ or 31. 7 per cent below the March valuation of $\$ 68,234$. Brake and clutch lining imports in April declined 5.6 per cont in value to $\$ 20,376$ from the March total of $\$ 21,583$. Receipts of asbestos packing were recorded at 8,111 pounds worth $\$ 3,542$ as against 13,505 pounds at $\$ 5,777$ in March. Other asbostos products to a value of $\$ 22,654$ were importad in April; tho United States suppliod 74.2 per cent of these, Great Britain, 25.2 par cont, and Switzerland and Germany tho remaindor. In March tho valuo of other asbestos products was $\varangle 40,874$ and the United States contributed 50.9 per cent, Great Britain, 46.7 por cont, and Gemany tho remainder.
