ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA, JULY, 1934.

Canada produced 12,042 tons of asbestos in July as compared with 13,719 tons in June and 14,805 tons in July, 1933, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the seven months ending July, the total Canadian output was 79,930 tons, an increase of 24.2 per cent over the production in the corresponding months of 1933.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in July declined to 11,463 tons from the June total of 12,846 tons. The United States purchased 78.6 per cent of the July exports.

Imports of asbestos products in July were worth \$67,272 as against the June valuation of \$64,346. Asbestos brake and clutch lining importations in July were appraised at \$20,831, or 25.6 per cent below the June total. Receipts of asbestos packing increased slightly in July when 13,909 pounds valued at \$5,771 were imported as compared with 10,443 pounds at \$4,056 in the preceding month. Other asbestos manufactures to a value of \$40,670 were imported during July; the June importations were worth \$32,287.
