MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1936.

Shipments of asbestos by Canadian producers in October advanced to 38,231 tons from the September total of 31,067 tons and the October, 1935 total of 27,144 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. An increase of 43.6 per cent was recorded in the tonnage shipped during the first ten months of 1936 as compared with the total for the corresponding period of 1935; the quantities were 242,556 tons and 168,955 tons, respectively.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in October rose to 34,714 tons from the preceding month's exportations of 26,730 tons. The United States received 82.5 per cent of the Canadian exports in October.

Asbestos products imported into Canada in October were valued at \$94,983 as compared with the September valuation of \$61,629. Receipts of brake and clutch lining were appraised at \$36,005 or 35.8 per cent above the previous month's total. Asbestos packing imports were higher in October and amounted to 10,081 pounds worth \$4,393. Importations of other asbestos products into Canada in October were worth \$54,585, made up of 50.9 per cent from the United States, 49.0 per cent from Great Britain and the remainder from Germany.
