## MONTHLY REPORT

## ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - OCTOBER, 1937.

Canadian producers reported shipments of ashestos amounting to 33,471 tons in October compared with 39,211 tons in the preceding month and 38,231 tons in October,1936, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. Shipments during the first ten months of 1937 totalled 342,502 tons; in the corresponding period a year ago, 242,556 tons were shipped.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in October advanced to 36,929 tons from the September total of 34,069 tons. Shipments to the United States accounted for 67.6 per cent of the October exportations.

Canada imported asbestos products to a value of \$102,429 in October against the preceding month's import valuation of \$109,635. Brake and clutch lining importations were valued at \$25,341 against \$35,263 in September. Receipts of asbestos packing declined to 6,421 pounds worth \$3,923 from the previous month's total of 8,662 pounds at \$4,360. Other asbestos products appraised at \$73,165 were imported in October; these imports were obtained from the following sources - Great Britain, 59.3 per cent; the United States, 41.6 per cent, and Germany and France, the remainder.
