NONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1937.

Shipments of asbestos by Canadian producers in February advanced to 27,301 tons from the preceding month's total of 22,454 tons, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In February, 1936 shipments amounted to 17,038 tons. During the first two months of the current year, 49,755 tons of asbestos were shipped as compared with 34,054 tons shipped in the corresponding period of 1936.

Exports of asbestos from Canada during February were recorded at 24,543 tons; in the preceding month 19,594 tons were exported. Shipments to the United States accounted for 85.9 per cent of the February exports.

Canada imported asbestos products valued at \$71,202 in February as against the January import valuation of \$81,094. Receipts of brake and clutch lining during February were appraised at \$19,679 or 45.6 per cent below the January total. Asbestos packing importations rose to 6,653 pounds worth \$3,611 from the January imports of 5,902 pounds at \$3,206. The value of other asbestos products imported in February amounted to \$47,912; the United States supplied 61.0 per cent of this total, Great Britain, 38.8 per cent and Austria and Germany, the remainder.
