MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JUNE, 1937 TY DE THI

Canadian producers shipped 35,341 tons of asbestos in June, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In May, 37,636 tons were shipped while in June, 1936, shipments amounted to 23,136 tons. During the first half of the current year 197,745 tons of Canadian asbestos were shipped as compared with 120,331 tons a year ago.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in June were recorded at 33,731 tons or 18.4 per cent below the tonnage exported in the preceding month. Sixty-five per cent of the June exports were consigned to the United States.

Asbestos products imported into Canada in June were valued at \$90,640; the preceding month's imports were worth \$98,076. Receipts of brake and clutch lining during June were appraised at \$33,496; this represented a decline of 24.8 per cent from the previous month's valuation. Asbestos packing imports were recorded at 7,858 pounds at \$3,447 as compared with 9,582 pounds worth \$4,381 imported in May. Other asbestos products importations in June were valued at \$53,697 and included 57.0 per cent from the United States, 42.9 per cent from Great Britain, and the remainder from Germany and Belgium.
