MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - JULY, 1937.

Shipments of asbestos by Canadian producers in July amounted to 35,194 tons; in the preceding month 35,341 tons were shipped while in July, 1936, shipments were fower at 27,749 tons, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the seven months ending July, 232,939 tons were shipped as compared with 148,130 tons a year ago.

Canada exported 32,843 tons of asbestos in July; during June, 33,731 tons were exported. The United States received 71.4 per cent of the July exports.

Imports of asbestos products into Canada in July increased 32.8 per cent in value to \$120,415 over the previous month's total. Brake and clutch lining importations were valued at \$34,524 as against \$33,496 in June. Receipts of asbestos packing rose to 23,006 pounds worth \$7,205 from the preceding month's imports of 7,858 pounds at \$3,447. Imports of other asbestos products into Canada were appraised at \$78,684 and consisted of 61.3 per cent from the United States, 37.9 per cent from Great Britain and the remainder from Belgium and Germany.
