MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - DECEMBER, 1930.

The Canadian shipments of asbestos in December amounted to 17,473 tons according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In November, 29,471 tons were shipped while in December, 1937, shipments totalled 28,771 tons. During the calendar year 1938 Canadian producers shipped 289,822 tons compared with 410,026 tons in 1937 and 301,287 tons in 1936.

Customs' records show that Canada exported 26,661 tons of asbestos in December; during the preceding month, 30,012 tons were exported. The United States received 58.3 per cent of the December exports; Germany, 14.7 per cent; Japan, 8.4 per cent; Belgium, 5.0 per cent; Great Britain, 4.0 per cent, and other countries, 9.6 per cent.

Imports of asbestos products into Canada were valued at \$55,304 compared with the previous month's import valuation of \$98,193. The December imports were as follows:-


The United States supplied 59.3 per cent of the above imports; Great Britain, 39.7 per cent, and Belgium, Germany and France, the remainder.
