MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1938.

Canadian producers reported shipments of asbestos amounting to 12,177 tons in February compared with 16,845 tons in January and 27,301 tons in February, a year ago, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first two months of 1938 shipments totalled 29,022 tons or 41.7 per cent below the tonnage shipped in the corresponding months of 1937.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in February declined to 13,053 tons from the preceding month's total of 17,921 tons and the February, 1937, exports of 24,543 tons.

The value of asbestos products imported into Canada in February increased 22.1 per cent to \$\( 0.75,051 \); the January imports were worth \$\( 0.61,442 \). Brake and clutch lining importations were appraised at \$\( 0.34,846 \) against the previous month's import valuation of \$\( 0.25,512 \). Asbestos packing receipts were recorded at 4,113 pounds worth \$\( 0.2,486 \); in January, 10,097 pounds at \$\( 0.3,076 \) were imported. Other asbestos products to a value of \$\( 0.37,717 \) were brought into Canada in February; the United States supplied 68.6 per cent of these imports; Great Britain, 27.1 per cent Belgium and Germany, the remainder.
