## ASBESTOS PIODUCTION IN CANTATI - FEFRTJAFI, 1938.

- Canadian producers reported shipments of asbestos anounting to 22,177 tons in Februcry compared with 16,845 tons in Janlary ard 27,301 tons in Fobruny, a year ago, accordine to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureeu of Statistios at Ottara. Dring tho first tro months of 1938 shiments toiziled $25,0 \mathcal{E}$ tons or $41 . "$ per cent below the ionnage shipped in the corresponding montis of 1937.

Exports of asbestos from Candida in February declined to 35,053 wons from the proceding montin's total. of 17, 221 tons and the February, 1957, exporitis of 24,543 tons.

The value of asbestos products irported into Canada in February increased 22.1 per cent to 75,051 ; the Janvary iuports were wortil 51,442 . Brane and clutch lining importetions mere appraised at 34,846 aqzinst the preious month ${ }^{1 / 3}$ import valuation of $25,51 \%$. Asbestos packing receipts :rer: reconded at $\hat{\varepsilon}, 113$ pounds porth $\{2,438$; in Jonuary, 10,097 pounds et $\$ 3,075$ were impowec. Dther asbostis products to a value of $\$ 37,717$ \%ere brought into Canada ir Febuuner, the United States supplied 68.6 per cent of those imports; Great Britain, 27.1 per cent. Belcium and Gemany, the remainder.
