MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA _ APRIL, 1938.

Shipments of Canadian asbestos amounted to 24,642 tons in April compared with 22,281 tons in the preceding month and 42,267 tons in April, 1937, according to a statement just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. During the first four months of 1938 Canadian producers shipped 75,945 tons of asbestos; a year ago, 124,768 tons were shipped.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in April totalled 21,176 tons of which the United States received 46.3 per cent and Japan, 40.3 per cent. In March, 17,013 tons were exported and the United States purchased 65.4 per cent of this total.

Asbestos products imported into Canada in April were valued at \$78,952 or 17.4 per cent below the March import valuation. Imports of brake and clutch lining were appraised at \$29,283 compared with \$33,111 in the preceding month. Receipts of asbestos packing in April were worth \$2,135; the March imports were valued at \$5,151. A decline of 17.1 per cent was recorded in the receipts of other asbestos products in April; the total for the month was \$47,484 made up of 60.3 per cent from the United States, 39.5 per cent from Great Britain, and 0.2 per cent from Belgium.
