MONTHLY REPORT

ASBESTOS PRODUCTION IN CANADA - FEBRUARY, 1940

Canadian producers shipped 21,326 tons of asbestos during February, according to a report just issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. In January, 26,651 tons were shipped while in February, 1939 shipments amounted to 21,824 tons. During the first two months of the current year, Canadian shipments aggregated 47,977 tons compared with 40,004 tons a year ago.

Exports of asbestos from Canada in February rose to 24,944 tons from the preceding month's total of 22,028 tons. The United States received 60.7 per cent of the February exports.

Customs' records show that Canada imported asbestos products to a value of \$95,111 in February as against the January valuation of \$101,310. The February receipts were as follows:
