SECTION I

Diamond Drilling of Deposits other than Fuels

This portion of the report includes statistics for industry 098—Other Contract Drilling of the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (Cat. no. 12-501).

During 1960 the footage drilled by contract diamond drilling was 5,521,211 compared with 5,435,971 in 1959. Income received from drilling was \$17,056,676. There were 59 firms reporting

their operations in this industry. Drilling was reported in all provinces and territories. The average number of employees was estimated at 1,912 and the salaries and wages totalled \$7,977,782.

Equipment owned by the operators included 340 air or steam-driven drills, 586 gasoline-driven drills and 47 electric driven drills.

SECTION II

Contract Drilling for Fuels

This report includes statistics for industry 096—Contract Drilling for Petroleum of the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (Catalogue no. 12-501).

Drilling for petroleum or natural gas, direct, or exploratory drilling for these minerals was reported by 94 contractors. The total reported footage was 13,770,531 feet and the income from operations amounted to \$75,240,796 compared, respectively, with 13,345,500 feet and \$63,815,776 in 1959. Rotary drilling amounted to 13,538,783 feet and 231,746 feet were done by cable drills.

The firms owned 352 rotary drills and 46 cable drills.

Supplies used during the year included 15,131 tons of bentonite, Pembina clay, etc., valued at \$842,331 625 tons of barite valued at \$49,023; drilling bits, cables and lubricants valued at \$75,896,665; general repairs to rig, \$8,729,325 and casing pipe was valued at \$401,300. Data on supplies are incomplete as many items are furnished to the contractor drillers by the well owners.

Drilling done by oil companies with their own equipment is not included in this report.
