# CONTRACT DRILLING FOR THE MINING INDUSTRY 1962

#### SECTION I

#### Diamond Drilling of Deposits other than Fuels

This portion of the report includes statistics for industry 098—Other Contract Drilling of the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (Catalogue number 12-501).

During 1962 the footage drilled by contract diamond drilling was 5,549,733 compared with 5,290,813 in 1961. Income received from drilling was \$17,907,424. There were 58 firms reporting

their operations in this industry. Drilling was reported in all provinces and territories. The average number of employees was estimated at 1,926 and the salaries and wages totalled \$7,985,202.

Equipment owned by the operators included 363 air or steam-driven drills, 378 gasoline-driven drills, 13 electric driven drills and 260 diesel driven drills.

#### SECTION II

#### Contract Drilling for Fuels

This report includes statistics for industry 096—Contract Drilling for Petroleum of the Standard Industrial Classification Manual (Catalogue number 12-501).

Drilling for petroleum or natural gas, direct, or exploratory drilling for these minerals was reported by 72 contractors. The total reported footage was 12,712,203 feet and the income from operations amounted to \$62,152,954 compared, respectively, with 12,787,048 feet and \$68,591,114 in 1961. Rotary drilling amounted to 12,459,736 feet and 252,467 feet were done by cable drills.

The firms owned 322 rotary drills and 42 cable drills.

Supplies used during the year included 9,971 tons of bentonite, Pembina clay, etc., valued at \$552,301; 2,958 tons of barite valued at \$172,435; drilling bits, cables and lubricants valued at \$7,929,461; general repairs to rig, \$9,057,935 and casing pipe was valued at \$1,497,156. Data on supplies are incomplete as many items are furnished to the contractor drillers by the well owners.

Drilling done by oil companies with their own equipment is not included in this report.
