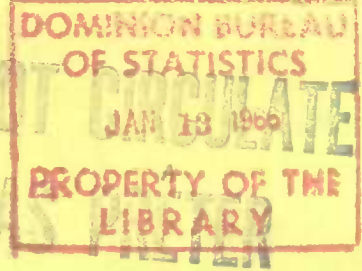

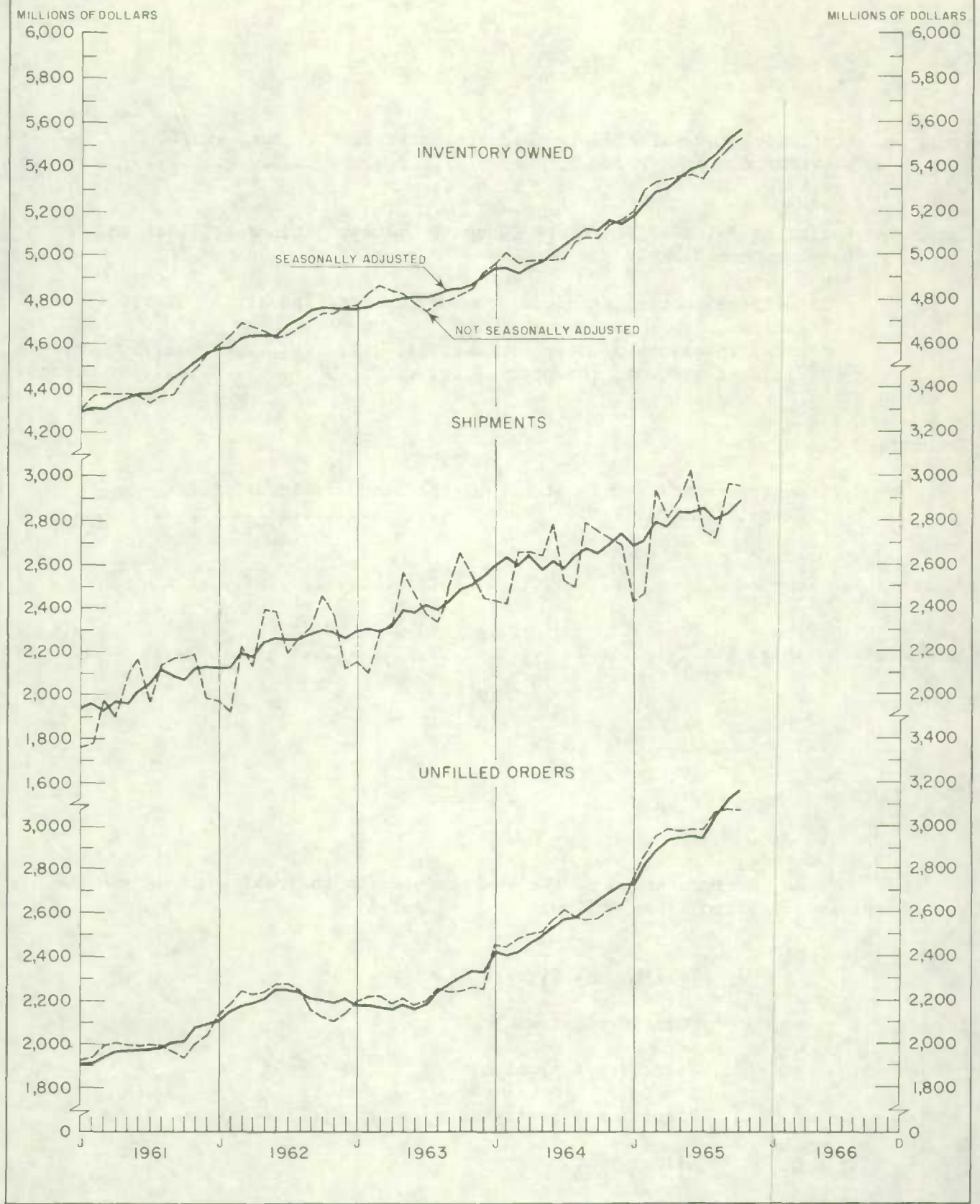

ESTIMATED VALUES OF SHIPMENTS, INVENTORY OWNED AND UNFILLED ORDERS IN ALL MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES



Following seasonal trends, preliminary October estimates of manufacturers' shipments, new orders and unfilled orders were slightly lower than the revised September values and inventories were somewhat higher. However, after adjustment for seasonal variation, all series reflected small to moderate gains.

Unadjusted October shipments at \$2,957 million were 0.4 per cent lower than the September figure of \$2,968 million but 7.4 per cent higher than in October 1964. Seasonally adjusted October shipments at \$2,894 million, reflected a 2.5 per cent increase from September. Cumulative shipments for the ten month period were \$27,937 million compared with \$26,149 million in the same period last year.

A 1.2 per cent increase in durables shipments to \$1,363 million from \$1,346 million was more than offset by the 1.7 per cent drop in non-durables shipments to \$1,594 million. Compared with October, 1964, durables shipments were 13.2 per cent higher and non-durables shipments 2.9 per cent up. Unadjusted data indicated that heavier than usual shipments in the motor vehicles industry and moderately higher shipments of paper and allied products, wood manufacturing, petroleum and coal products were offset by decreases in the other major manufacturing industry groups.

Manufacturers' inventories owned at the end of October rose 0.5 per cent to \$5,529 million from September. At this level they were 9.0 per cent higher than in October, 1964. Total inventories held rose 0.7 per cent to \$5,837 million in October from \$5,795 million in the preceding month. After seasonal adjustment to \$5,893 million, they were 1.1 per cent higher than in September. Increases in manufacturers' inventories at the end of October were again largely concentrated in goods in process and only slightly shown in raw materials and finished products. The ratios of inventories owned to shipments at 1.87 and of finished products inventories to shipments at 0.66 were fractionally higher than the revised ratios of 1.85 and 0.65 respectively in September.

As in the previous two months, the accumulation of inventories at the end of October was larger in durable goods manufacturing than in non-durables. Nearly two-thirds of the gain in inventories owned came from a 4.0 per cent increase in the transportation equipment industries. Other substantial increases in inventories owned were reported in primary metal, paper and allied products and foods and beverages industries, while inventories were markedly down in September in petroleum and coal products, wood manufacturing and electrical products industries. All major groups except petroleum and coal products, reported higher inventories in October than in the same month last year.

New orders received in manufacturing in October were estimated at \$2,954 million. The seasonally adjusted estimate of \$2,932 million was 1.2 per cent higher than the \$2,897 million value in September.

Unadjusted unfilled orders at the end of October of \$3,074 million were little changed from the revised September level of \$3,076 million but 19.5 per cent higher than in October, 1964. Seasonally adjusted unfilled October orders were 1.2 per cent above the September mark. The 0.4 per cent increase in unfilled orders in durable goods industries in October was more than offset by the 2.5 per cent decrease reported by non-durables producers. Compared with corresponding levels in 1964 unfilled orders of durables and non-durables manufacturers at the end of October were 20.6 per cent and 13.9 per cent higher respectively.

CONCEPTS

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 4) - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Manufactures values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 and 3) - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - (Tables 2 and 3) - are defined as orders on books at the end of the period stated. That is, they cover orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - (Tables 2 to 4) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with the manufacturing operations of the establishment covered whether held at plant or elsewhere, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of: raw materials, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture less the value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - (Tables 2 and 3) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 and 3) - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from Inventory owned by the inclusion of inventories held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tables 2 and 3) - Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to define the components specifically for each industry.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is not longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Groupings - The Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Tables 3 and 4 are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A list of the industries included in the Standard Industrial Classification groups will be found on page 40 of the bulletin.

SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Two industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and they are also included in the total inventory estimates.

FOOTNOTES TO TABLES

TABLE 1. - (1) Prince Edward Island, Yukon and Northwest Territories are not published separately. They are included in the total for Canada.

TABLE 3. - (1) The value of Unfilled Orders and, therefore, of New Orders for industries in major groups - 1, 2, 6, 8, 9, 10, 17, 18 and 19 is small and sample coverage is not adequate to provide separate estimates for them.

(2) The value of inventory held but not owned in this group is very small, and sample coverage is not adequate to provide separate data. Estimates for this type of inventory are included with Total Inventory Held; for all practical purposes this can be considered the equivalent of Inventory Owned.
