





T R E N D S U M M A R Y

Preliminary estimates indicate the following trends for October:

SHIPMENTS: Total value of manufacturers' shipments for the month, at \$1,926 million, was \$102 million (6%) above the level of September, 1956. The cumulative total was \$17,851 million, 12% higher than the total of \$16,206 million for the same period of 1955.

Increases during October were general. All industry groups (Standard Industrial Classification) showed increases with the exception of Wood Products which declined by \$7 million (5%) and Electrical Apparatus which remained unchanged. Largest increases were registered in Rubber Products, \$3 million (11%); Foods, Beverages and Tobacco Products, \$19 million (5%); Textiles, \$3 million (5%); Clothing, \$5 million (6%); Paper Products, \$10 million (6%); Transportation Equipment, \$29 million (22%); Non-Ferrous Metals, \$10 million (8%); Non-Metallic Mineral Products, \$7 million (15%); and Petroleum Products, \$13 million (12%). All industry groups showed increases as compared with October, 1955, with the exception of Textiles which declined by \$1 million (1%). All groups showed increases as compared with 1955 in the 10-month cumulative comparison. The bulk of the increases were in the 5 - 12% range. The increase in the Iron and Steel group was, however, 23%; while Non-Metallic Minerals increased by 15%.

Using Economic-Use Classification industries showing increases as compared with October, 1955, were Perishable Consumers' Goods (13%); Semi-Durable Consumers' Goods (5%); Heavy Transportation Equipment (20%); Other Capital Goods (25%); Construction Goods (18%); Export Goods (7%); Motor Vehicles and Related Industries (20%); Intermediate Goods and Supplies (10%); and Unclassifiable Industries (14%). Durable Consumers' Goods Industries remained unchanged. All groups showed increases for the first ten months of the year as compared with the same period of 1955, with the exception of Durable Consumers' Goods which showed no change. The largest increases were 14% in Heavy Transportation Equipment; 21% in Other Capital Goods and 18% in Construction Goods.

INVENTORIES: Value of inventory owned by manufacturers, at \$4,077 million was \$44 million (1.1%) higher than the revised September value of \$4,033 million. The October level was \$500 million (14%) higher than at the end of October, 1955.

Value of inventory held but not owned at \$559 million was practically unchanged from the revised September level of \$558 million. The change in total inventory held, therefore, was an increase of \$45 million from the previous month. Raw Materials and Goods in Process increased by \$25 million (1.3%) and \$26 million (2.1%) while Finished Products declined by \$6.5 million (0.5%). During 1952 and 1954, total value of inventory owned declined by \$11 million and \$2 million, while in 1953 and 1955, it rose by \$14 million and \$30 million, respectively, indicating an apparent lack of any pronounced seasonal pattern for total inventory in October.

Changes in total inventory owned during October for Standard Industrial Classification Groups, were on the whole, upward. The increase in total was largely caused by increases in the following groups:- Foods, Beverages and Tobacco industries, \$9 million (1%); Paper Products, \$5 million (2%); Iron and Steel Products, \$17 million (3%); Heavy Transportation Equipment, \$26 million (8%); Petroleum Products, \$4 million (2%); and Chemical Products, \$3 million (1%). The largest declines were registered in Clothing, \$8 million (4%); Wood Products, \$11 million (4%); and Electrical Apparatus, \$3 million (1%).

Using the Economic-Use Classification, the main increases during October occurred in the following industries:- Heavy Transportation Equipment, \$3 million (3%); Other Capital Goods, \$7 million (3%); Motor Vehicles and Related Industries, \$23 million (9%); and Intermediate Goods and Supplies, \$30 million (5%). Largest declines during the month occurred in Perishable Consumers' Goods, \$9 million (1%); and Semi-Durable Consumers' Goods, \$8 million (3%).

The ratios of total inventory owned to shipments at 2.12 and of finished products inventory to shipments, at 0.71 were down slightly from September levels. In both cases, the levels were slightly below the average for the year to date.

ORDERS: New orders received during October were \$1,877 million, up \$40 million (2%), from the revised September values, but \$192 million (11.4) higher than in October 1955. Since new orders were lower than shipments for the month, total Unfilled Orders declined by \$49 million (2%). The value of Unfilled Orders, at \$2,715 million, was \$141 million (6%) higher than at the end of October 1955.

Trends during the month in individual industries and groups were generally downward with increases registered in only three groups: Leather Products, \$3 million (11%); Textiles, \$3 million (3%); and Chemical Products, \$3 million (2%). Largest declines occurred in Foods, Beverages and Tobacco Products, Wood Products, Paper Products, Iron and Steel, Heavy Transportation Equipment, Non-Ferrous Metal Products, Electrical Apparatus and Miscellaneous Industries.

#### CONCEPTS AND SOURCES

#### CONCEPTS

Shipments - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.

New Orders - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - are defined as estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of:

- (a) raw materials;
- (b) goods in process;
- (c) finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse;
- (d) goods of own manufacture at manufacturers' sales offices, wholesale outlets and retail stores;
- less (e) value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components.

Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common, although because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods, there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered, to some extent, incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of progress payments inventory. It includes items (a) to (d) as shown above under total inventory owned.

Inventory Components - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to make definitions of components appropriate for each industry as a whole.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings, but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 4) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Table 2, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A description of the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Table 3) will be found in the December 1955 report, Page 5.

#### SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 2,700 plants in 118 industries; in addition, 2,400 small plants in 21 of these industries and one additional industry report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,034 plants in 95 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
