## TEEND SUMMARY

Preliminary reports indicate the following trende for February :
Shipments: Totel vilue, at $\$ 1627.8$ million, was $\$ 57$ million or $3.7 \%$ higher than the revised January figure, and $\$ 180$ million or $11.2 \%$ higher than in February, 1955. Cumulative total for the first two months was $12.6 \%$ higher than for the same period of 1955 .

Increases during February were general, with very few industries showing declines and only four industries registering declines as large as $\$ 3$ to $\$ 5$ million - Slaughtering and Meat Packing, Rallroad Rolling Stock, Non-Ferrous Metals Smelting and Refining, and Petrolewm Products. Industries showing increases of $\$ 4$ million or over included Womens' Factory Clothing, Mens' Factory Clothing, Shipbuilding, Agricultural Implements, Automobiles, and Primary Iron and Steel.

By Standard Industrial Classification groups, largest increases in value during Pebruary, were $\$ 18$ million in Iron and Steel products, $\$ 14$ milion in Clothing, and $\$ 12$ million in Transportation Equipment. Using the Economic-Use groups, the largest increases were \$18 million in Consumers' Semi-Durables and $\$ 10$ million in Intermediate Goods and Supplies.

Cumalative values for the first two wonths as compared with the same period in 1955, for the Standard Industrial Classification groups, showed the largest percentage increases in Iron and Steel Products (34\%), Wood Products ( $26 \%$ ), and Non-Metallic Minerals (28\%). Only two groups showed declines - Rubber Products and Transportation Equipment ( $5 \%$ each). Using Economic-Use groupings, the cumblative comparison showed the largest increases in the construction Goods group ( $44 \%$ ) and Intermediate Goods and Supplies (19\%). Motor Vehicles and Related Industries showed the only decline (9\%).

Inventories: Total value of inventory onned rose for the sixth consecutive month. At $\$ 3836.4$ million the February value was $\$ 67$ million or $1.8 \%$ above the revised January level and $\$ 273$ million or $7.7 \%$ above February 1955. Inventory held under progress payments arrangements rose $\$ 12$ million during February, giving an increase of $\$ 79$ million for total inventory held. Of this latter increase, $\$ 28$ million occurred in raw materials, $\$ 33 \mathrm{million}$ in goods-in-process, and \$17 milion in finished products.

Incresses in individual industries were fairly widespread. Motor Vehicles and Sheet Metal Products showed the largest value increases, of $\$ 19$ miliion and $\$ 10$ million respectively. Dalry Products registered a seasonal decline, dropping $\$ 7$ million, and the only other industry to show arge decline was Primary Iron and Steel ( $\$ 4$ million).

By Standard Industrial Classification groups, the largeat increases during February were in Transportation Equipment ( $\$ 26$ million), Iron and Steel Products ( $\$ 23$ million) and Wood Products ( $\$ 15$ million), while Food and Beverages declined $\$ 8$ milion. Using the Economic Use groupings, Motor Vehicles and Related Industries showed an increase of $\$ 25$ million, Construction coods incressed $\$ 16$ million, wile 11 other groups fincreased by smaller amounts with the exception of Perishable Consumer Goods and Intermediate Goods and Supplies, which declined by $\$ 3$ and $\$ 8$ million respectively. Because of increases in shipments during February, inventory-shipments ratios decreased from the revised January levels. The February ratio for total inventory onned to shipments was 2.36 , silghtly lower than the average for 1952 , 1953 and 1954, but above the average level in 1955. The ratio for finished products to shipments was 0.78 , which is very slightly higher than the average in 1952 and 1955 , but silightly below the average for 1953 and 1954.

Orders: Total value of New Orders, at $\$ 1699.4$ million, was $\$ 21$ million or $1.2 \%$ lower than the revised Jmuary value but $\$ 210$ million or $14 \%$ above the February, 1955 level. The February New Orders were higher than shipments, resulting in an increase in Unfilled Orders for the fourth consecutive month. At $\$ 2858.8$ million, the latter were $2.6 \%$ above the Jamuary level and $10.8 \%$ athove February, 1955.

Increases in Unfilled Orders were general, with the largest in the Rallroad Rolling Stock industry ( $\$ 15$ million), Automobile Parts ( $\$ 19$ million) and Flour Mills ( $\$ 7$ million).

The ratio of Unfilled Orders to Shipments at the end of February was 1.7; excluding the \&leavy Transportation Equipment industries, the ratio was 1.4 .

## CONCEPTS

Shipments - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.

New Orders - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, get of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - are defined as estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders recelved but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory owned - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of:
(a) raw materials;
(b) goods in process;
(c) finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse;
(d) goods of own manufacture at manufacturers* sales offices, wholesale
outlets and retail stores;
less (e) value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components.

Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned $=$ represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers total inventory holdings which are no longex owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common, although because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods, there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered, to some extent, incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of progress payments inventory. It includes items (a) to (d) as shown above under total inventory owned.

Inventory Components - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Pinished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to make definitions of components appropriate for each industry as a whole.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two icems differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings, but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/ inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 4) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Table 2, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A description of the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Table 3) will be found in the December 1955 report, Page 5.

## SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventorles and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 2,700 plants in 118 industries; in addition, 2,400 small plants in 21 of these industries and one additional industry report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,034 plants in 95 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
