## Preliminary estimates indicate the following trends in June:

Shipments: Total value for the month, at $\$ 1,878.3$ million, declined $1.4 \%$ from the revised May level. Apart from the My record values, the June level was the highest this year and was 6.5 percent above the highest single month in 1955 (September). The level was $7.6 \% \mathrm{higher}$ than in June of 1955 . Cumulative value for the first six months was $\$ 10,515$ miliion, $11.2 \%$ higher than for the similar period of 1955 .

In general, declines occurred during June in Clothing, Transportation Equipment, and Chemical industries, and increases in Foods and Beverages, and Wood Products. The largest changes in individual industries were as follows: Motor Vehicles (down $\$ 10$ milion); Fertilizers (down $\$ 4.5$ million); Non-Ferrous Metals (down $\$ 5$ million); Petroleum Products (down $\$ 4$ miliion); Women's Factory Clothing (down $\$ 3.5$ million); Motor Vehicle Parts (down $\$ 3 \mathrm{million}$ ); Men's Factory Clothing (down $\$ 2.5 \mathrm{million}$ ); Leather Products (down $\$ 2$ million); Sawills (up $\$ 13 \mathrm{million}$ ) S Sash, Door and Planing Mills (up $\$ 6$ million); Slaughtering and Meat Packing (up $\$ 5$ miliion); and Breweries (up $\$ 2.5$ miliion).

For industry groupings, changes during the month were largely reflections of these individual industry changes. By Standard Industrlal Classification groups, Foods, Beverages and Tobacco were up $2 \%$, Leather Products down $12 \%$, Clothing down $10.5 \%$, Non-Ferrous Metals down $4 \%$, Petroleum Products down $2 \%$, Chemical Products down $8 \%$, while other groups showed little change. By Economic Use Groupa, Perlshable Consumers Goods were up $3 \%$, Semi-Durable Consumers Goods down $10 \%$, Heavy Transportation Equipment down $4 \%$, Construction Goods up $5 \%$, Motor Vehicles down $8 \%$, Intermediace Goods and Supplies down $4 \%$, while other groups showed little change.

With the exception of Textiles and Wood Products in the Standard Industrial Classification (both of which were down $5 \%$ from June'55) June values for all groups were higher than in June of last year by anything from 3 to $23 \%$. The cumulative comparison for the first six months of both years shows 1956 higher in all groups. Using the Standard Industrial Classification, the smallest increase over $1955 \mathrm{was} 5 \% \mathrm{in} \mathrm{Foods}$, Beverages and Tobacco; while Iron and Steel Products were up 27\%; Non-Metallic Minerals up $17 \%$; Electrical Apparatus up 15\%; Non-Ferrous Metals, and Rubber Products up $14 \%$ each. Using Economic Use groups, the smallest increase for the first six months over the same period of 1955 was in Motor Vehicles and Related Industries (up $5 \%$ ), while Construction Goods and Capital Goods (other than Heavy Transportation) were each up $21 \%$ and Intermediate Goods and Supplies were up $15 \%$.

Inventories: Value of inventory owned rose by $\$ 39$ mililon ( $1 \%$ ) in June, for the tenth consecutive monthly increase. The total value at the end of June was $\$ 3,958$ million. This was $11.5 \%$ higher than in June, 1955 , and almost $7 \%$ higher than at the end of December, 1955.

Inventory held but not owned (held under progress payments arrangements) rose by $\$ 2$ million during June. Value of total inventory held was, therefore, up $\$ 41$ million ( $0.9 \%$ ) above the May level and $\$ 399$ milifon, or $9.7 \%$ higher than at the end of June, 1955. Of the total increase during June, $\$ 14$ million occurred in raw materials and almost. $\$ 27 \mathrm{milion}$ in finished products, while goods in process remained little changed. As compared with June 1955, Law materials were up $\$ 203$ million ( $12 \%$ ); goods in process were up $\$ 73$ million ( $6 \%$ ), and finished products $\$ 123 \mathrm{million}(10 \%$ ). Increases in the various components since December 1955 were $\$ 98$ million ( $5 \%$ ) for raw materials; $\$ 58 \mathrm{milifon}(5 \%$ ) for goods in process and $\$ 121 \mathrm{million}$ ( $10 \%$ ) for finished products.

The trends in components indicate a probable switch during the first half of 1956 from a voluntary to an involuntary inventory build-up. Of the total increase of $\$ 203$ milifon in raw materials since last June, $\$ 171$ million came in the six-month period October 1955 to March 1956 , and the rate of increase in this component during the next quarter was considerably lower than this. On the other hand, almost the entire increase in finished products occurred from December to June, with the biggest single month's increase in January, and the second largest in June. However, the June increase in finished products of $\$ 27$ million should be considered against a history of June increases ranging from $\$ 13$ to $\$ 26$ million in the previous four years - this is partly a result of seasonal production in various industries, and possibly also a build-up prior to holiday periods in July.

There were a relatively high number of large changes in individual industries during June, both up and down. The largest were in Dairy Products (up $\$ 13 \mathrm{million}$ ), Primary, Iron and Steel (up $\$ 10$ million), Sawmils (up $\$ 8$ million) and Automobiles (down $\$ 6$ million). By Standard Industrial classification groups, the largest changes during June were an increase of $\$ 21$ milifon (3.4\%) in Iron and Steel Products and a decrease of $\$ 14$ million (4.3\%) in Transportation Equipment. Groups with increases of more than $20 \%$ as compared with June 1955 included Rubber Products, Iron and Steel Products, Transportation Equipment and Non-Metallic Minerals. By Economic-Use groups, the largest percentage changes during June were declines of $4 \%$ each in Heavy Transportation Equipment, and Motor Vehicles and Related Industries. Most of the other groups increased, but by smaller proportions. Groups with increases of more than $20 \%$ as compared with June 1955 included Construction Goods, and Motor Vehicles and Related Industries.
Orders: New Orders Received during June were $\$ 1,788 \mathrm{milli}$ on, $\$ 77$ million ( $4 \%$ ) below May values but almost $4 \%$ higher than in June 1955. Since shipments during the month were higher than new orders, total unfilled orders declined by $\$ 90$ million ( $3 \%$ ). The value of unfilled orders, at $\$ 2,724$ million, was $6.5 \%$ higher than at the end of June 1955. The largest changes in Unfilled Orders during June were declines of $\$ 40$ million in Aircraft, $\$ 15$ million in Pximary, Iron and Steel, $\$ 11$ million in Motor Vehicle Parts, and $\$ 9$ milion in Railroad Rolling Stock.

## CONCEPTS

Shipments - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.


#### Abstract

New Orders - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Recelved during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlugs.

Unfilled Orders - are defined as estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.


Total Inventory owned - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of:
(a) raw materials;
(b) goods in process;
(c) finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse;
(d) goods of own manufacture at manufacturers' sales offices, wholesale outlets and retail stores;
less (e) value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to spectific components.

Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-tem contracts are common, although because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of varlations in accounting methods, there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered, to some extent, incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of progress payments inventory. It includes items (a) to (d) as shown above under total inventory owned.

Inventory Components - (Raw Materlals, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and complled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to make definitions of components appropriate for each industry as a whole.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings, but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/ inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but ncet owned had been included with goods in process.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 4) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Table 2, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A description of the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Table 3) will be found in the December 1955 report, Page 5.

## SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 2,700 plants in 118 industries; in addition, 2,400 smali plants in 21 of these industifes and one additional industry report monthly shipments only. of the first group, 1,034 plants in 95 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
