## TREND SUMMARY

SHIPMENTS - Value of manufacturers' shipments during February, at $\$ 1,041.8$ million was nearly $\$ 72$ million ( $4 \%$ ) lower than the revised January total of $\$ 1,713.4$ million. (The December estlmate has also been revised downard to $\$ 1,725.4$ million). Shipments for the month were $1.3 \%$ greater than in February, 1956, and the cumulative total for the first two months of the year was $6.2 \%$ greater than for the same period last year.

The February decline in shipments was in contrast with increases of between 3 and $6 \%$ for this month in each of the previous four years. The largest decreases during the month occurred in Slaughtering and Meat Packing, Motor Vehicles, Motor Vehicle Parts, Non-Ferrous Metals Smelting and Refining, and Petroleum Refining industries. Of these decreases, the one in Slaughtering and Meat Packing appeared in line with the normal February pattern, while for Non-Ferrous Metals Smelting and Refining and for Petroleun Refining, the declines were considerably larger than normally occurring in February in recent years.

INVENTORY - Value of inventory owned by manufacturers continued to rise. The value at the end of February was $\$ 4,219.7$ million, $\$ 65$ million ( $1.6 \%$ ) higher than the revised January value of $\$ 4,155.0$ million. (The December value has also been revised upward to $\$ 4,114.2$ million). The February level was $\$ 443$ million or $11.7 \%$ higher than last year's February value of $\$ 3,776.4$ million.

The increase in total inventory during February while higher than for the same month in 1953, 1954 and 1955, was siightly lower than the February increase in 1956.

Inventory held under progress payments arrangements rose by nearly $\$ 2$ million in February. Total inventory held (including both inventory owned and inventory held under progress payments arrangements) stood at $\$ 4,720.2$ million at the end of February, as compared with $\$ 4,653.6$ million at the end of January, and $\$ 4,220.1$ million at the end of February 1956. The February level was $1.4 \%$ higher than at the end of January and 11.9\% higher than at the end of February 1956. The increase of $\$ 67$ million in total inventory held during February came largely from finished products, which rose by $\$ 40.7$ million (2.9\%). Goods in process increased by $\$ 10.8$ mililon ( $0.9 \%$ ), while raw materials increased by $\$ 15$ miliion ( $0.8 \%$ ). Raw materials and goods in process were $10 \%$ higher than at the end of February last year while the finished products component was $15 \%$ higher.

Increases in total inventory owned were general to almost all Standard Industrial Classification groups. Individual industries which showed the largest increases during the month were Tobacco and Tobacco Products (15\%), Wood Products (3\%), Iron and Steel Products (1\%), Transportation Equipment (7\%), Non-Metallic Mineral Products (5\%). Increases in all these industries generally occur in February, but this year the increases were slightly higher than in the past few years.

The ratio of total inventory owned to shipments was 2.57 as compared to 2.43 in January, and 2.33 in February 1956. The ratio of finished products to shipments stood at 0.89 as compared to 0.83 in January, and 0.78 in February 1956.

ORDERS - Unfilied orders declined by $\$ 3.4$ million ( $0.1 \%$ ) during February to $\$ 3,226.2$ million as compared with the revised January level of $\$ 3,229.6$ million and the revised December value of $\$ 3,141.4$ million. The February level was $\$ 177.9 \mathrm{million}(5.8 \%) \mathrm{higher}$ than the February 1956 value of $\$ 3,048.3$ million. Decreases were general in all groups (Standard Industrial Classification) with the exception of Transportation Equipment which showed a $3 \%$ increase. Largest decreases were registered in Iron and Steel Products and Non-Metallic Mineral Products.

The bracketed letters following the individual industry titles indicate the series in which the industry is included on the basis of monthly reparts from finm or from special estimates (s) means that the industry is covered for the shipments series; (i) for the inventory series; (o) for the orders series. Industries for which monthly coverage is not indicated are included in the all-industry and group total estimates as described on page 44.

A single asterick preceding the individual industry title indicates that the data for the industry are shown separately in Table 4. A double asterick indicates that the data for the industry are show in Table 4 combined with data for one or more similar indugtries as indicated in the footnotes for that table.

CONCEPTS

Shipments - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.

New Orders - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selifig values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfllled Orders - are defined as estimated selling value, at the end of the period stared, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of:
(a) raw materials;
(b) goods in process;
(c) finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse;
(d) goods of own manufacture at manufacturers' sales offices, wholesale
outlets and retall stores;
less (e) value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be agaigned to specific components.

Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where lous-isto contracts are comm, although because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Sabause of variations in accounting methods, there are few cases where it is not possible to obtain : in ins io: this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered, to some extent, incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of progress payments inventory. It includes items (a) to (d) as shown above under tocal inventory owned.

Inventory Components - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to make definitions of components approprinte inr each industry as a whole.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings, but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the cotal value of iaventory held but not owned would be afsi:3sl:l: to $£$ infshed products or raw materials.

A:Hy comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total ind:cor held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/ inW:ncory ratios are desired using lnventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not aried had been included with goods in process.

Industries and Groupings $=$ All individual industries (Table 4) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Table 2, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A description of the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Table 3) will be found in the December 1955 report, Page 5.

## SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by $2,700 \mathrm{plants}$ in 118 industries; in addition, 2,400 small plants in 21 of these industries and one additional industry report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,034 plants in 95 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments ostimates by using data available from other Bureau serles, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
