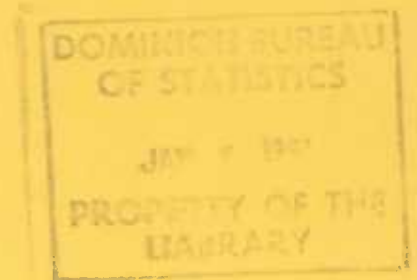

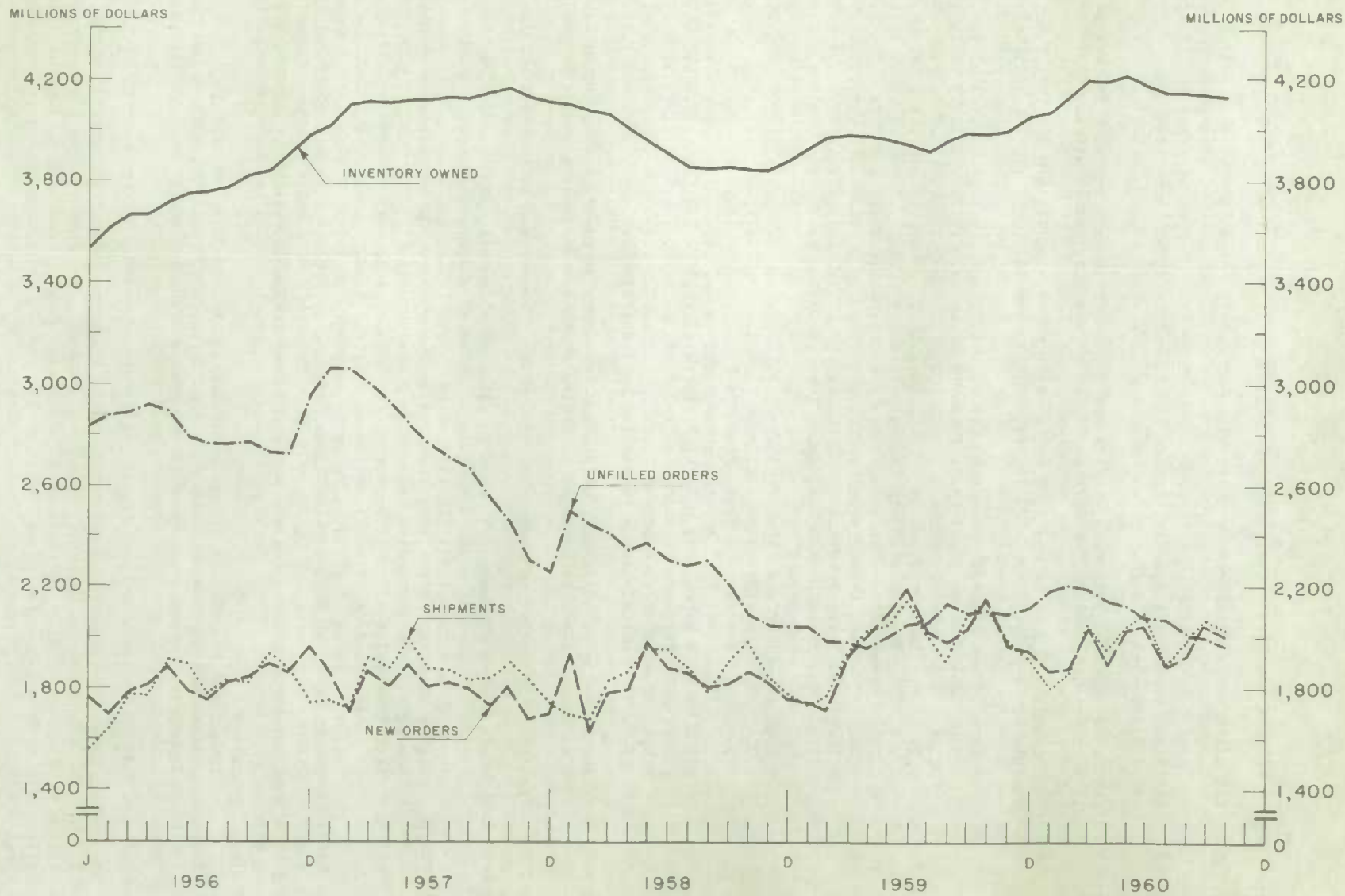

# ESTIMATED VALUES OF SHIPMENTS, INVENTORY OWNED, AND ORDERS IN ALL MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES



TREND SUMMARY

Preliminary estimates indicate the following trends for October:

**SHIPMENTS:** - The value of manufacturers' shipments in October was estimated at \$2,023 million, a decrease of 2.2 percent from the revised September value of \$2,069 million and a decrease of 5.5 percent from the October 1959 value of \$2,142 million. Shipments for the year to date, at \$19,772 million were \$35 million lower than the comparable 1959 value of \$19,807 million.

Shipments during the first quarter of this year were much higher than the first quarter of 1959 but the edge initially held has been gradually eroded throughout the year until for the first time this year, the cumulative total is lower than similar total of 1959. Usually, first quarter shipments are the lowest of the four quarters and, in fact, have been the lowest for the last eight years averaging less than twenty-four percent of the annual volume. Shipments are usually heaviest during the second quarter with the fourth quarter next but averaging nearly one percent less. Third quarter shipments are usually close in value to fourth quarter shipments. During the fourth quarter, shipments have tended recently to follow quite closely two distinct seasonal patterns depending on the fall peak. Generally there are three peaks in the annual shipments series: one in March, another in May or June and the last in September or October. In 1954 and 1955 the fall peak was in September and the decline for the remaining months of the year was quite moderate. Since 1956 the fall peak has been in October and the decline to the end of the year was sharp, holding fairly closely to ten percent, and apparently uniform. These two patterns have kept the value of fourth quarter shipments quite consistently between twenty-five and twenty-six percent of the annual value. The extensive declines this October are more typical of 1954 and 1955 than the years since in which the fall peak was recorded in October with most groups showing increases during the month. There is too, as a point of interest, a distinct similarity in the movements of the raw data between 1955 and 1960 particularly since May.

Declines were recorded in all the groups of both the Standard Industrial Classification and the Economic-Use Classification except for the transportation group in the former and heavy transportation equipment and motor vehicles and related industries in the latter. Among the larger declines were iron and steel products (8 percent), non-ferrous metal products (7 percent) and chemical products (8 percent). These three groups accounted for \$41 million or half of the gross decrease in shipments. The only increase in the Standard Industrial Classification groups was in the transportation group of 31 percent or \$36 million which left a net decrease in shipments of \$45 million. The increase was reflected in the Economic-Use groups, heavy transportation equipment, of 9 percent or \$4 million and motor vehicles and related industries of 32 percent or \$31 million. It should be noted that the two transportation groups of the Economic-Use groups are not identical to the transportation group of the Standard Industrial Classification.

**INVENTORIES:** - Total inventory owned by manufacturers at the end of October of \$4,131 million was down fractionally from the revised September value of \$4,137 million, but up 4 percent from the October 1959 value of \$3,986 million.

Total inventory held, of \$4,412 million was virtually unchanged from September but up fractionally from the October 1959 value of \$4,385 million. Inventory held under progress payments arrangements increased two percent from \$275 million in September to \$281 million in October but decreased thirty percent from October 1959. The latter change occurred chiefly in the transportation industries.

Inventory components appeared to follow through the shifts noted last month. Raw materials were up 0.3 percent, goods in process were down 0.6 percent, finished products were virtually unchanged while goods in process minus progress payments were down 1.4 percent.

Among the industries classified according to the Standard Industrial Classification, three groups showed large dollar changes in inventory owned for October. The first, foods and beverages, increased \$16 million or 2 percent. This increase is of a seasonal nature occurring during the latter half-year and falling off in December. The second large change was a \$13 million or 1.8 percent decline in iron and steel products. This change is not unusual for this group in size or direction but possibly is a continuation of a long-term cyclical downturn from the peak in May, in its turn built up gradually from a low in the last quarter of 1958. The last large dollar change, in chemical products, was an

increase of \$11 million or 4.6 percent. This change is a normal response to a seasonal accumulation which usually start to build up in the last quarter and declines during the first half to a low plateau in the summer.

The above large changes were not reflected very clearly in the Economic-Use groupings. Many of the industries causing the large changes in the Standard Industrial Classification groups do not lend themselves to easy classification in the Economic-Use groupings and are in the miscellaneous groupings where their changes are not easily noticed. However, intermediate goods and supplies increased \$18 million or 2.8 percent and the change reflects a large part of the above-noted changes in the Standard Industrial Classification groups.

Other changes in October were considerably smaller in volume and none were large in percentage terms. Changes since October 1959 show moderate increases for most groups. Larger changes show paper products up 7.3 percent, non-ferrous metal products up 8.1 percent, electrical apparatus and supplies up 12.3 percent, miscellaneous manufacturing industries up 7.0 percent and leather products down 7.1 percent.

The ratio, total inventory owned to shipments, moved to 2.04 in October from 2.00 in September and 1.86 last October. The ratio, finished products to shipments, moved to 0.67 in October from 0.65 in September and 0.58 last October.

**ORDERS:** - The preliminary estimate of the value of unfilled orders at the end of October was \$1,966 million, down 1.2 percent from the revised value at the end of September of \$1,989 million and down 6.6 percent from the October 1959 value of \$2,105 million. The decline from September was centered in a \$22 million drop in the capital goods industries of the Economic-Use groupings. The other larger changes from September were a decrease of \$5 million in the unclassifiable industries and a \$6 million increase in the intermediate goods and supplies industries. The large changes from October 1959 were a 27 percent drop in perishable consumers' goods, a 7.7 percent drop in heavy transportation, a 9.7 percent drop in motor vehicles and related industries, a 19.3 percent drop in intermediate goods and supplies and a 18.2 percent increase in industries manufacturing largely for export.

The value of new orders in October of \$2,000 million was 2.3 percent below September and 7.1 percent below October 1959.

**TRADING OUTLETS:** - Sales of goods of own manufacture through manufacturers' trading outlets in October were estimated at \$242 million a decrease of 0.4 percent from September and a decrease of 5.6 percent from October 1959. Changes among the trading outlet groups were generally small with the following exceptions: wood and paper down 7 percent, electrical apparatus down about 14 percent, products of petroleum and coal up 4 percent, and chemical industries down 10 percent.

Inventories held at manufacturers trading outlets at the end of October were estimated at \$295 million, a decrease of 2 percent from September, and an increase of 1 percent from October 1959. Changes were generally small, the largest in percentage terms being an increase in foods and beverages of 5 percent and a decrease of 4 percent in the iron and steel industries.

C O N C E P T S

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 5)- represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - are defined at estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of: raw materials, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse, less value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of amounts held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tables 2 to 5) - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to define the components specifically for each industry.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Trading Outlets - (Table 7) - are defined as any establishments (other than retail stores) operated by manufacturers, apart from their plants or plant-warehouses, which carry stocks and make sales direct to customers. Sales offices which merely arrange sales but do not carry stock, or which carry small quantities only for demonstration purposes, are not included. Sales for this series represent direct sales from the outlet of goods manufactured by the owning or associated manufacturing company, with sales arranged by outlets but shipped direct from plant excluded wherever possible; goods purchased for re-sale from sources other than the owning or associated manufacturing company are also excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry group where a separation of purchased products is not feasible. Inventories for this series represents owned inventories held at Trading Outlets or in warehouses serving the trading outlets; again, goods purchased for re-sale are excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 5) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Tables 3, 6 and 7, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A list of the industries included in the Standard Industrial Classification groups and in the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Tables 4, and 6) will be found on page 52 of the bulletin.

S O U R C E S

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
