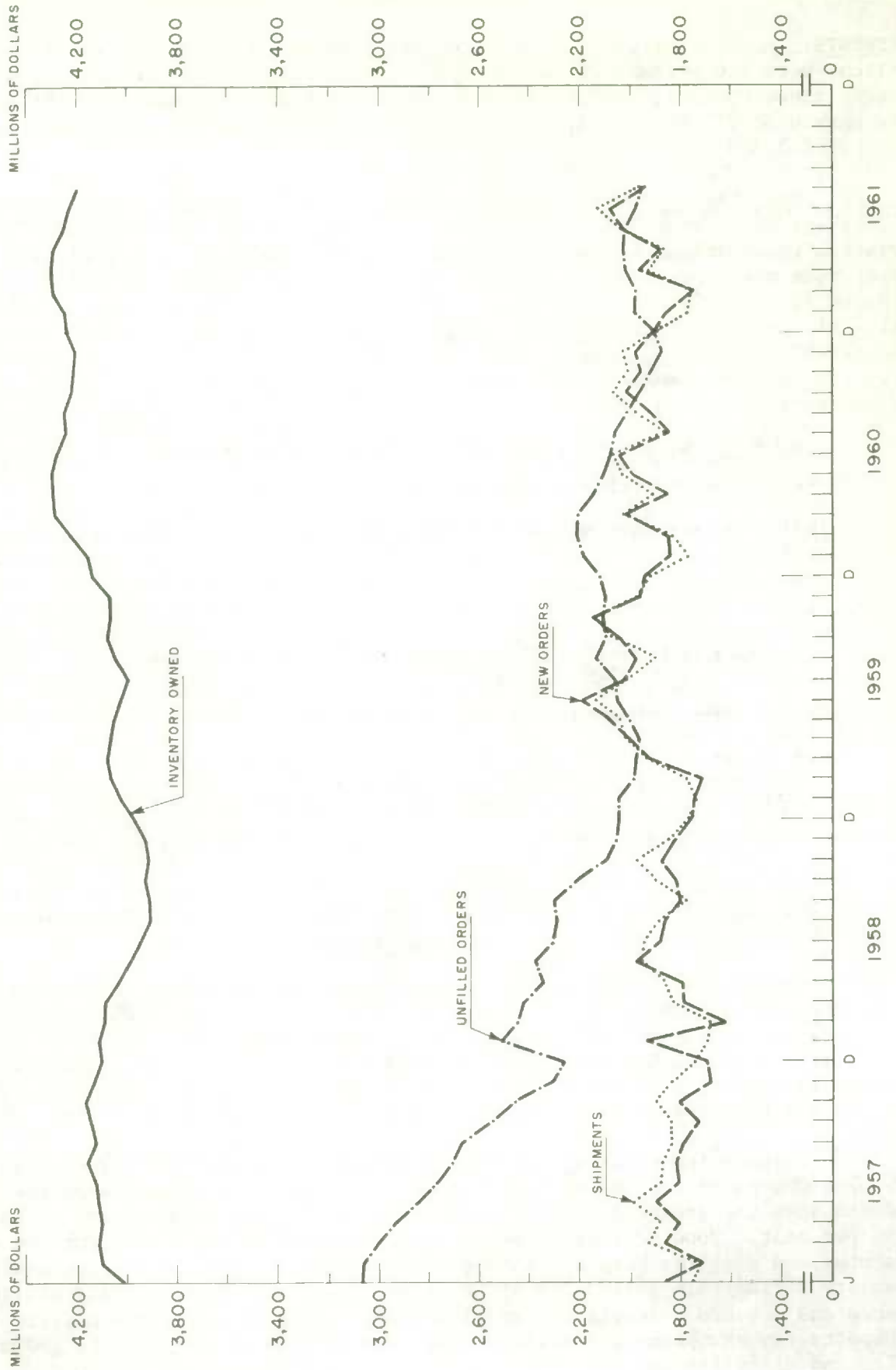

TREND SUMMARY

SHIPMENTS: Manufacturers' shipments in July, valued at a preliminary \$1,965.7 million, were 7.6 percent below the revised June value of \$2,128.2 million and 5.7 percent above the July 1960 value of \$1,859.5 million. Shipments in the January - July period at \$13,483.1 million were little changed from the corresponding 1960 total of \$13,500.8 million.

Only three groups of the Standard Industrial Classification showed increases in July and these were minor in value terms. The largest declines were in transportation equipment of \$52 million (28%), chemical products of \$27 million (19%), non-ferrous metal products of \$15 million (9%), paper products of \$15 million (8%), iron and steel products of \$14 million (5%), and foods and beverages of \$12 million (3%). All groups of the economic use classification declined in July except for semi-durable consumers' goods industries which recorded an increase. The largest percentage declines were in motor vehicles and related industries (30%), heavy transportation equipment (15%), and intermediate goods and supplies (12%).

Shipments invariably decline from June to July and the group changes this year are comparable to those of previous years.

INVENTORIES: The preliminary estimate of the value of inventories owned by manufacturers at the end of July of \$4,197.9 million was 0.7 per cent below the revised June estimate of \$4,228.9 million and 1.1 per cent below \$4,242.7 million in July, 1960. The preliminary estimate of inventory held by manufacturers at the end of July of \$4,391.6 million was 0.8 per cent below the revised June estimate of \$4,425.7 million and 3.2 per cent below \$4,534.5 million in July 1960. Inventories held under progress payments arrangements at \$193.7 million in July were 1.6 per cent below the June value of \$196.8 million and 33.6 per cent below the July 1960 value of \$291.7 million.

The changes in components for July were as follows: raw materials up 1.1 per cent, goods in process down 3.0 per cent, finished products down 1.7 per cent, and goods in process minus the value of progress payments down 3.3 per cent.

The ratio of total inventory owned to shipments was 2.14 in July, 1.99 in June and 2.28 in July, 1960. The ratio of finished products to shipments was 0.72 in July, 0.68 in June, and 0.76 in July, 1960.

Inventories owned by manufacturers declined from June to July in ten groups of the Standard Industrial Classification. The largest value declines were in transportation equipment industries of \$25 million, and in iron and steel products of \$8 million. Increases among the six groups were quite moderate and the largest in value terms were in foods and beverages of \$6 million, paper products of \$7 million, and chemical products of \$4 million.

Changes in inventory owned by manufacturers from July, 1960 to July, 1961 show nine groups of the SIC at lower levels this year than last. Iron and steel products show the greatest decline in both value and percentage terms of \$86 million or 11 per cent. Wood products have declined \$21 million or 7 per cent and electrical apparatus and supplies have declined \$19 million or 6.1 per cent. Increases in inventory during this period are as follows: foods and beverages \$23 million (4%), tobacco and tobacco products \$22 million (16%), paper products \$19 million (5%), transportation equipment \$12 million (5%), non-ferrous metal products \$30 million (10%), and miscellaneous manufacturing \$4 million (5%).

Inventories continued their decline into July which is the fourth month of continuous liquidation. Since the high in March, inventories held by manufacturers have declined \$158 million of which raw materials have contributed \$48 million, goods in process \$65 million, and finished products \$44 million. The present liquidation showed first in raw materials when the usual year-end build-up increase of this component gave way to a firm decline in March. The decline continued for three months before ending in an accumulation this month. Goods in process inventory did not decline until May; finished products started to decline in April and both components continued down this month.

So far in the present liquidation, the timing and direction of changes in the components conform quite closely to typical seasonal patterns and probably half of the decline can be attributed to purely seasonal forces. The non-seasonal aspect lies almost entirely in the extent of the liquidation. The decline in raw materials and in progress payments have both been more severe than the experience of previous years would indicate. Goods in process inventory less the value of progress payments has also declined somewhat more extensively than usual. Finished products inventory on the other hand, while conforming generally to a seasonal pattern, has showed strong resistance to change and the level remains high. In June 1960 and June 1961 for example the percentage split of components was as follows (1960 in parenthesis): raw materials 43.4 (43.6), goods in process 23.9 (24.9), finished products 32.7 (31.6).

While the outlook for inventories during August is for further slight liquidation the evidence is somewhat clouded. Accentuated seasonal movements have been responsible, it appears, for the liquidation to date but the seasonal pattern in August is less pronounced than for other months. Preliminary data for shipments - new orders and backlogs for iron and steel products clearly show signs of strengthening demand, which, if resulting in inventory accumulation in August may swamp the seasonal movements in other groups.

ORDERS: New orders received by manufacturers in July at a preliminary \$1,942.7 million were down 6.8 per cent from the revised June value of \$2,083.6 million and up 5.1 per cent from \$1,848.0 million in July 1960.

The balance of unfilled orders at the end of July of \$1,954.8 million was down 1.2 per cent from \$1,977.7 million in June and down 5.4 per cent from \$2,066.6 million in July 1960. Among the industry groups of the economic use classification the largest percentage decrease from June to July was in perishable consumers' goods industries of 10 per cent. The largest percentage increase, in the motor vehicles and related industries, was 7 per cent. Changes from July 1960 to July 1961 were greatest in the capital goods sector, in construction goods, and in industries producing largely for export. The capital goods sector and construction goods were both down about 10 per cent. The group of industries producing largely for export was 10 per cent above last July.

TRADING OUTLETS: Sales through manufacturers' trading outlets fell 4.5 percent from \$237.7 million in June to \$226.9 million in July. The largest percentage declines in sales were foods and beverages (11%), chemical industries (22%), and all other industries (10%). Increases were minor.

Inventories held at manufacturer's trading outlets increased at the end of July by 1.6 percent to \$304.9 million from \$300.0 million a month earlier. The largest percentage change was a decline of 8.1 percent in inventories of purchased goods of the electrical apparatus industries.

C O N C E P T S

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 5) - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - are defined at estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of: raw materials, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse, less value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of amounts held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tables 2 to 5) - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to define the components specifically for each industry.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Trading Outlets - (Table 7) - are defined as any establishments (other than retail stores) operated by manufacturers, apart from their plants or plant-warehouses, which carry stocks and make sales direct to customers. Sales offices which merely arrange sales but do not carry stock, or which carry small quantities only for demonstration purposes, are not included. Sales for this series represent direct sales from the outlet of goods manufactured by the owning or associated manufacturing company, with sales arranged by outlets but shipped direct from plant excluded wherever possible; goods purchased for re-sale from sources other than the owning or associated manufacturing company are also excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry group where a separation of purchased products is not feasible. Inventories for this series represents owned inventories held at Trading Outlets or in warehouses serving the trading outlets; again, goods purchased for re-sale are excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 5) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Tables 3, 6 and 7, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A list of the industries included in the Standard Industrial Classification groups and in the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Tables 4, and 6) will be found on page 53 of the bulletin.

S O U R C E S

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
