## OCTOBER SUMMARY


#### Abstract

Manufacturers' shipments in October were valued at an estimated $\$ 2,331.8$ million, up 5.2 per cent from the revised september value of $\$ 2,216.1$ million and up 9.1 per cent from the $\$ 2,137.6$ million reported in October 1961. Shipments in the January - October period were valued at $\$ 21,418.5 \mathrm{million}$, 8.4 per cent higher than the corresponding 1961 total of $\$ 19,764.9$ million.


The seasonally revised series indicates the increase in October to be less than usual, as the seasonally adjusted value, at $\$ 2,160.3$ million, is 1.4 per cent lower than the revised seasonally adjusted September total. The October value, however, is over five per cent higher than a year ago.

Inventories owned by manufacturers' at the end of October were practically unchanged from the revised September estimate at $\$ 4,582.6$ million versus $\$ 4,581.0$ million, but were 5.3 per cent higher than last year's October total of $\$ 4,350.3$ million. Inventories held by manufacturers at the end of October, at $\$ 4,874.1$ mililon, were fractionally lower than the revised September estimate of $\$ 4,877.4$ million and 7.2 per cent higher than the October 1961 estimate of $\$ 4,548.0$ million.

The ratio of total inventory-to-shipments was 1.97 in October versus 2.07 in September and 2.04 in October 1961. The ratio of finished products-to-shipments was 0.63 in October against 0.67 in September and 0.65 a year ago.

In the seasonally adjusted series, the shifts in October were insignificant in comparison with September.

New orders in October were valued at an estimated $\$ 2,304.8$ million, up 6.8 per cent from the revised September estimate of $\$ 2,157.8$ miliion and up 9.4 per cent from the October 1961 total of $\$ 2,106.5$ million. Unfilled orders were estimated in October at $\$ 2,035.4$ million, down 1.3 per cent from the revised September estimate of $\$ 2,062.4$ miliion but up 10.4 per cent from the october 1961 estimate of $\$ 1,843.9$ million.

[^0]Provincial Shipments- Shipments were higher in value in October this year as compared to last in eight of the ten provinces, as follows: Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia, 20.5 per cent; Quebec, 8.1 per cent; Ontario, 11.8 per cent; Manitoba, 1.0 per cent; Saskatchewan, 3.0 per cent; Alberta, 3.3 per cent; and British Columbia, 5.5 per cent. Declines of 0.8 per cent and 8.0 per cent were recorded in Newfoundland and New Brunswick, respectively.

Higher values of shipments in October this year as compared to last in Prince Edward Island and Nova Scotia reflects greater shipments in wood, fron and steel, transportacion equipment and petroleum products industries; in Quebec to gains in textiles, wood, paper, iron and steel, and transportation equipment; in Ontario to advances in wood, paper, iron and steel, transportation equipment, electrical, and chemical products; in Alberta to increases in foods and beverages, wood, non-metallic minerals, and petroleum products that more than offset a substantial decrease in fron and steel; and in British Columbia to gains in wood, and paper products. The decline in New Brunswick was due to decreases in wood, and transportation equipment.

## CONCEPTS

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 5) = represent an estimated projection, on monthly basis, of the latest available Censur of Industry values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as sil New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Oxders - (Tables 2 to 5) - are defined at estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of: raw materdals, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse, less value of inventoxy held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This icem is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are comon although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of varlations in accounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs Erom fnventory owned by the inclusion of amounts held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tables 2 to 5) - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i. e. thexe has been no attempt to define the components specifically fox each industry.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obein value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipmentsfinventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which hsve slready been written off to sales. If shipments inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Trading Outlets - (Table 7) - axe defined as any establishments (other than retail stores) operated by manufacturers, apart Erom their plants or plant-warehouses, which carry stocks and make sales direct to customers. Sales offices which merely arrange sales but do not caxry stock, or which carry small quantities only for demonstration purposes, are not included. Sales for this series represent direct sales from the outlet of goods manufactured by the oming or assoctated manufacturing company, with sales arranged by outlets but shipped direct from plant excluded wherever possible; goods purchased for re-sale from sources othex than the owning or associated manufacturing company are also excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry group where a separation of purchased products is not feasible. Inventories for this series represents owned inventories held at Txading Outlets or in warehouses serving the trading outlets; again, goods purchased for re-sale are excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 5) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Tables 3, 6 and 7 , are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A ilst of the industries included in the Standard Industrial Classification groups and in the Economic-Use grouplngs of industries (Tables 4 , and 6) will be found on page 53 of the bulletin.

## SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. Of the Exrst group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other gureau serles, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
