SHIPMENTS: Manufacturers' shipments in May were valued at an estimated $\$ 2,210.6$ million, up 7.8 per cent from the revised April value of $\$ 2,050.2$ million and up just slightly less, 7.3 per cent, from the May 1961 value of $\$ 2,060.3$ miliion. Shipments in May 1961 exceeded, on a month to month comparison, shipments in the previous year for the first time and continued to do so for the remainder of the year. The increase over the previous year on a month to month comparison has continued for the first five months of this year. Using the seasonally adjusted shipment series, however, the value of shipments altho' slightly higher in April 1961 than in April 1960 did not reach the higher level until June of last year. In 1962 shipments seasonally adjusted have been higher each month than in the corresponding month last year but the increase was only fractionally higher in April than in March and moved down in May. In value terms seasonally adjusted shipments were almost stable in the first quarter of 1962 , rose by nearly 3 per cent in April and declined in May to the lowest level in seven months; the increases shown, that is, in both March and May of this year, have been less than would have been expected according to the seasonal pattern of manufacturers' shipments.

INVENTORIES: Inventories owned by manu£acturers at the end of May amounted in value to $\$ 4,523.9$ million down 0.3 per cent from the revised April value of $\$ 4,535.7$ million and up 4.9 per cent from the May 1961 value of $\$ 4,312.7$ million. Inventories held by manufacturers at the end of May were valued at $\$ 4,782.1$ million, down fractionally fron the revised April value of $\$ 4,787.9$ million and up 5.7 per cent from the May 1961 value of $\$ 4,523.8$ million.

The ratio of inventory owned to shipments was 2.05 in May, 2.21 in April and 2.09 in May 1961. The ratio of finished products to shipments was 0.68 in May, 0.75 in April and 0.70 in May 196l.

The very slight changes in inventory values in May as compared with the two previous months appears to mark the end of the period of inventory accumulation which began in mid 1961 and continued through the first three months of the year. Upward changes in all S.I.C. groups were minor with only three showing increases of more than 2 per cent, a $\$ 1.5$ million increase in leather products, a $\$ 4.3$ million increase in clothing and a $\$ 6.5$ million increase in transportation equipment. These increases were more than balanced by the 3.5 per cent drop in chemical products inventories of $\$ 9.9$ million; the equal in value terms in the food industries was of approximately the same amount, $\$ 9.2$ million, altho' this is just over 1 per cent in this industry; these two and other minor declines result in the net decline of $\$ 11.7$ million in total inventory owned, a negligible amount in terms of the total value of stocks of $\$ 4,523.9$ million.

The estimates of inventory held by manufacturers show little difference in the proportions held as raw materials, goods in process and finished goods since the changes were not large in any one component. The total increase in raw materials and goods in process was approximately two thirds of the amount of the decline in finished goods inventory. Half of the increase in goods in process inventory was inventory held under progress payments arrangements. Almost half of the decline in finished goods inventory took place in the processed food industries where the seasonal movement of the previous year's pack to market took place.

ORDERS: New orders received in May were valued at $\$ 2,202.1$ million, up 8.7 per cent from the revised April value of $\$ 2,025.8$ million and up 7.2 per cent from the May 1961 value of $\$ 2,053.6$ milition.

Unfilled orders in May were valued at $\$ 2,109.0$ million, down 0.4 per cent from the revised April value of $\$ 2,117.5$ million and up 8.1 per cent from the May 1961 value of $\$ 1,950.5 \mathrm{million}$.

The unfilled orders balance reached its low point last year in October - and began to move upward in November, a month earlier than in 1960, and at a sharper rate than that year. The declines in April and May have been slight and in fact on a seasonally adjusted basis the decline in April was negligible and May shows a slight rise.

TRADING OUTLETS: Sales through manufacturers' trading outlets in May were valued at $\$ 225.3$ million 3.6 per cent up from the revised April value of $\$ 217.5$ million and down 5.5 per cent from the May 1961 value of $\$ 238.5$ million.

Inventories held at trading outlets in May were valued at $\$ 267.4$ million 2.5 per cent up from the revised April estimate of $\$ 261.0$ million but 6.3 per cent down from the May 1961 value of $\$ 285.3$ million.

## CONCEPTS

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 5) - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest avallable Census of Industry values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. it is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the barae month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - are defined at estimated selling value, at the end of the perlod stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned = (Tables 2 to 5 ) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with manufacturing operations, whether heldat plant or not, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of: raw materials, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse, less value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - (Tables 2 to 5 ) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item 1s applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are comon although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for chis item must therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of amounts held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tables 2 to 5) - Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to define the components specifically for each industry

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, Bince the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owmed by componenta would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Trading Outlets - (Table 7) - are defined as any establishments (other chan retail atores) operated by manufacturers, apart from their plants or plant-warehouses, which carry stocks and make sales direct to customers. Sales offices which merely arrange sales but do not carry stock, or which carty small quantities only for demonstration purposes, are not included. Sales for this series represent direct sales from the outlet of goods manufactured by the owning or associated manufacturing company, with sales arranged by outlets but shipped direct from plant excluded wherever possible; goods purchased for re-sale from sources other than the owning or associated manufacturing company are also excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry group where a separstion of purchased products is not feasible. Inventories for this serles represents owned inventories held at Trading outlets or in warehouses serving the trading outlets; agaln, goods purchased for re-sale are excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry.

Industries and Groupings - All individual industries (Table 5) and the Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Tables 3, 6 and 7, are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A list of the induatries included in the Standard Industrial Classification groups and in the Economic-Use groupings of industries (Tables 4 , and 6) will be found on page 53 of the bulletin.

## SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reparts covering value of inventories and shipments are now subatted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. of the first group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the total inventory estimates.
