## TREND SUMMARY

Manufacturers' shipments in August were valued at an estimated $\$ 2,137.2$ million, up $0.8 \%$ from the revised July total of $\$ 2,119.5$ million and up $2.3 \%$ from $\$ 2,088.8$ milifon in August 1961. In the seasonally adjusted series the value of shipments in August at $\$ 2,077.6$ million was $5.1 \%$ lower than the revised July value of $\$ 2,190.3$ million and $2.1 \%$ higher than the seasonally adjusted estimate of $\$ 2,034.1$ million in August 1961.

The slight rise in manufacturers shipments in August marked the first downward movement in the seasonally adjusted series since January of this year. The seasonal increase expected in the textile and clothing industries in August was much less than usual and the seasonal drop in the transportation industries was much larger resulting in the larger than usual seasonal declines. It is perhaps somewhat ironical that the drop in shipments in the motor vehicle industry should show up so sharply in this month as it is becoming apparent that this year will probably be the largest year in the automobile industry's history. However the annual model change almost always shows up initially as a decline in August shipments.

New orders in the motor vehicle industry which reached record proportions in the four months from March to June this year have fallen back again; unfilled orders while never as high this year as in 1959 have been substantially higher this year than last.

Inventories owned by manufacturers at the end of August were valued at $\$ 4,533.7$ million, an increase of $1.3 \%$ from the revised July estimate of $\$ 4,475.7$ million and an increase of $6.0 \%$ from the August 1961 estimate of $\$ 4,278.0$ million. Inventories held by manufacturers at the end of August, valued at $\$ 4,821.2$ million, were up $1.1 \%$ from the previous month's estimate of $\$ 4,766.5$ million and up $7.6 \%$ from $\$ 4,480.6$ million a year ago. The ratio of total Inventory-to-shipments was 2.12 in August, 2.11 in July and 2.05 in August 1961. The ratio of finished products-tom shipments was 0.68 in August, 0.69 in July and 0.65 a year earlier.

The increase in inventories in August although not significant is interesting in that the greatest increase is shown in goods in process. (Finished Products inventory actually shows a slight decline although a lower decline than could have been expected as the seasonally adjusted series shows a slight rise). Thus the rise indicates an increase in manufacturing activity rather than an accumulation of manufactured goods although the ratio of finished products inventory to shipments does indicate an increase as compared with a year ago.

New orders received in August were valued at $\$ 2,133.1$ million, an increase of 1.1\% from the revised July total of $\$ 2,110.9$ million and an increase of $2.8 \%$ from the August 1961 value of $\$ 2,075.9$ million. Unfilled orders at the end of August, at $\$ 2,137.3$ million, were down fractionally from the July estimate of $\$ 2,141.4$ million but $11.4 \%$ higher than the $\$ 1,918.2$ million reported in August 1961.

Sales through manufacturers trading outlets, valued at $\$ 242.4$ miliion, were $2.0 \%$ higher than the revised July estimate of $\$ 237.7$ milion and $1.1 \%$ lower than the August 1961 value of $\$ 245.0$ million. Inventories held at trading outlets valued at $\$ 287.4$ million were fractionally higher than the July value of $\$ 286.5 \mathrm{million}$ and $5.5 \%$ lower than the $\$ 304.0$ million reported in August 1961.

## CONCE PTS

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 5) - represent an eatimated projection, on monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Industry values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is belng received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the order will be Eilled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - (Tables 2 to 5) - are defined at estimated selling value, at the end of the period stated, of orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory owned - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturera in connecion with manufacturing operations, whether held at plant or not, at the end of the period stated. it is made up of: raw materials, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture at plant and warehouse, less value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inveatory only, value of goods purchssed for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not owned (Tables 2 to 5) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-texm contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of varistions in mccounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item mat therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 to 5) - represents the estimaced total value of manufacturers inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of amounts held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tablea 2 to 5) - (Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products) are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, 1.e. there has been no attempt to define the components specificaliy for each industry.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, finms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is no longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of much payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lage in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments inventory ratios sre desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to tatal inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Trading Outlets - (Table 7) - are defined as any establishments (other than retail stores) operated by manfacturers, apart from their plants or plant-warehouses, which csriy atocks and make sales direct to cuscomers. Sales offices which merely arrange sales but do not carry stock, or which carry small quantities only for demonstration purposes, are not included. Sales for this series represent direct arles from the outlet of goods manufactured by the owning or associated manufacturing company, with sales arranged by outlets but shipped direct from plant excluded wherever possible; goods purchased for re-sale Erom sources other than the owning or associated manufacturing company are also excluded except Eor the Petroleum Products industry group where a separation of purchased products is not feasible. Inventories for this series represents owned inventories held st Trading Ontlets or in warehouses serving the trading outlets; again, goods purchased far re-sale are excluded except for the Petroleum Products industry.

Industries and Groupinga - All individual indugtries (Tabie 5) and the Standard Industrial Classificarion groupings of industries used in Tables 3,6 and 7 , are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A list of the industries included in the Standerd Industrial Clasaification groups and in the Economic-lae groupinga of industries (Tables 4 , and 6) w111 be found on page 53 of the bulletin.

## SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. OF the first group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Four industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and two of these are also included in the cotal inventory estimates.
