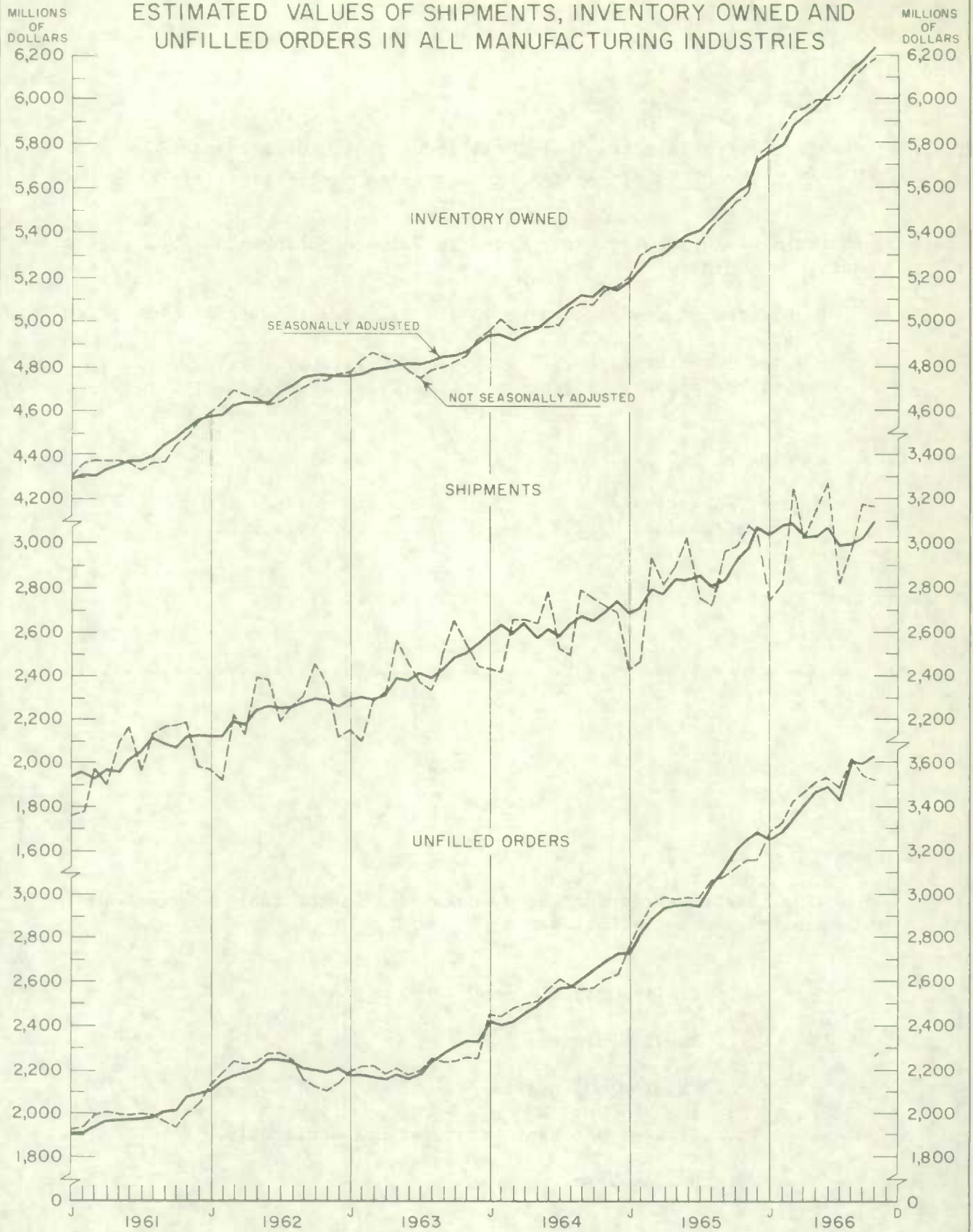

# ESTIMATED VALUES OF SHIPMENTS, INVENTORY OWNED AND UNFILLED ORDERS IN ALL MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES



### TREND SUMMARY

The preliminary estimate of manufacturers' shipments in October, valued at \$3,165 million, were off slightly from the revised September estimate of \$3,173 million. New orders received by manufacturers during October totalled \$3,145 million, 1.7 per cent above the value in September. Unfilled orders at the end of October dropped fractionally by 0.6 per cent from the level at the end of the previous month as the value of shipments slightly exceeded new orders for the month. After adjustment for seasonal factors, manufacturers' shipments, new orders and unfilled orders showed increases of 2.6 per cent, 3.7 per cent and 0.7 per cent respectively from the preceding month. Manufacturing stocks owned at the end of October edged up 0.7 per cent and 0.8 per cent after seasonal adjustment, from the end of September.

Total shipments for the first ten months of 1966 advanced 8.6 per cent to \$30,377 million from \$27,965 million for the comparable period in 1965, with a larger gain in the durable goods industries than in the non-durable goods industries. Among the major industry groups the highest relative increase in shipments to date in 1966 was registered by the machinery industries (17.6 per cent), followed by the increase in the electrical products industries (14.1 per cent).

In October, shipments of durable goods producers increased slightly from \$1,469 million to \$1,476 million, while non-durable goods producers reported a drop of 0.9 per cent from \$1,704 million to \$1,689 million. More noticeable decreases in October shipments, mostly seasonal, were recorded in the tobacco industries, the leather industries, the clothing industries, the metal fabricating industries and the non-metallic minerals industries. The large increase of shipments in the transportation equipments industries was, again, attributable mainly to a seasonal rise in the motor vehicle and parts industries.

At the preliminary estimate of \$1,466 million, durable goods manufacturers' new orders in October were 4.3 per cent higher than the revised figure of \$1,406 million in September. Outstanding orders of durable goods industries at the end of October declined slightly from \$3,020 million to \$3,010 million which was however, 15.3 per cent higher than at the end of October last year. The value of unfilled orders in October was 2.04 times shipments for the month.

Inventories held by manufacturers at the end of October were up 0.6 per cent to \$6,501 million, and 1.0 per cent to \$6,562 million seasonally adjusted, from the level at the end of the previous month. This accumulation of stocks in October occurred mainly in goods in process and finished products inventories. Stocks owned by durable goods producers at the end of October reached \$3,124 million, 0.7 per cent ahead of the previous month and 14.7 per cent above the level in October 1965; relatively significant increases were shown in the electrical products and the transportation equipment industry groups. Non-durable goods manufacturers also reported an increase of 0.7 per cent in owned inventories in October. A rather substantial stocks build-up in the food and beverage industries was partially offset by the large decreases in the tobacco industries and the petroleum and coal products industries.

Ratios of manufacturers' inventories owned to shipments and finished products to shipments in October were estimated at 1.95 and 0.68 respectively compared with 1.94 and 0.67 in the previous month and 1.86 and 0.65 in October 1965.

### CONCEPTS

Shipments - (Tables 1 to 4) - represent an estimated projection, on a monthly basis, of the latest available Census of Manufactures values.

New Orders - (Tables 2 and 3) - This series is designed to indicate the rate at which new business is being received. It is defined as all New Orders Received during the period, at estimated selling values. Thus it covers total new orders, net of cancellations, regardless of whether the orders will be filled from stock or as a result of activity during the same month (and, therefore, will also be reported as shipments in the month received) or whether they will be added to existing backlogs.

Unfilled Orders - (Tables 2 and 3) - are defined as orders on books at the end of the period stated. That is, they cover orders received but not yet shipped (or treated as a sale), irrespective of work done on them or of stocks from which they can be filled.

Total Inventory Owned - (Tables 2 to 4) - represents the estimated book value of inventory owned by manufacturers in connection with the manufacturing operations of the establishment covered whether held at plant or elsewhere, at the end of the period stated. It is made up of: raw materials, goods in process, finished goods of own manufacture less the value of inventory held but not owned which cannot be assigned to specific components. Since the series relates to manufacturing inventory only, value of goods purchased for re-sale is not included.

Inventory Held but Not Owned - (Tables 2 and 3) - represents, as far as possible, the portion of manufacturers' total inventory holdings which are no longer owned by the reporting manufacturers because of payments made on long-term contracts as work on these progresses. This item is applicable only to the relatively few industries where long-term contracts are common although, because of the nature of the item, the value per industry is high.

Because of variations in accounting methods there are a few cases where it is not possible to obtain values for this type of inventory. The estimated value shown for this item must therefore be considered to some extent incomplete.

Total Inventory Held - (Tables 2 and 3) - represents the estimated total value of manufacturers' inventory holdings in connection with manufacturing operations, regardless of ownership; it differs from inventory owned by the inclusion of inventories held under progress payments arrangements.

Inventory Components - (Tables 2 and 3) - Raw Materials, Goods in Process, and Finished Products are reported and compiled as on the books of each manufacturer, i.e. there has been no attempt to define the components specifically for each industry.

The inventory components are always a breakdown of total inventory held, not of total inventory owned. In industries where these two items differ, due to the inclusion of inventory held but not owned (see above), it is not possible to obtain value of inventory owned by components since, where separate progress accounts are maintained, firms concerned can only state that, of total holdings, a certain amount is not longer owned by them. It is fairly obvious that the bulk of such payments apply to goods in process holdings but due to time lags in shipments and to prepayments some of the total value of inventory held but not owned would be applicable to finished products or raw materials.

Any comparisons of shipments/inventory ratios should be made using total inventory owned, not total inventory held, since the latter includes values which have already been written off to sales. If shipments/inventory ratios are desired using inventory components, rather than total inventory, a reasonable approximation to total inventory owned by components would be obtained by assuming that all inventory held but not owned had been included with goods in process.

Groupings - The Standard Industrial Classification groupings of industries used in Tables 3 and 4 are defined according to the Standard Industrial Classification Manual. A list of the industries included in the Standard Industrial Classification groups will be found on page 40 of the bulletin.

### SOURCES

Monthly (or, in a few cases, quarterly) reports covering value of inventories and shipments are now submitted on a voluntary basis by 3,000 plants in 120 industries; in addition, 3,000 small plants in 100 of these industries report monthly shipments only. Of the first group, 1,025 plants in 83 industries also report new and unfilled orders. Two industries are included in the total shipments estimates by using data available from other Bureau series, and they are also included in the total inventory estimates.



FOOTNOTES TO TABLES

TABLE 1. - (1) Prince Edward Island, Yukon and Northwest Territories are not published separately. They are included in the total for Canada.

TABLE 3. - (1) The value of Unfilled Orders and, therefore, of New Orders for industries in major groups - 1, 2, 6, 8, 9, 10, 17, 18 and 19 is small and sample coverage is not adequate to provide separate estimates for them.

(2) The value of inventory held but not owned in this group is very small, and sample coverage is not adequate to provide separate data. Estimates for this type of inventory are included with Total Inventory Held; for all practical purposes this can be considered the equivalent of Inventory Owned.
