TYPE OF OWNERSHIP OF THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRIES, 1947

The present report is the second on the type of ownership under which Canadian manufacturers operate. The figures for 1947 include those for the fish curing and packing industry which were not available for the 1946 study. For this reason the figures for the two years are not strictly comparable. However, the inclusion of this industry in 1946 would not have materially altered the percentage distribution of individual ownership, incorporated companies, etc.

Of the 32,734 establishments operating in 1947, 15,195 were under individual ownership, 5,280 were partnerships, 11,222 were incorporated companies and 1,037 were co-operatives. The percentage distribution of the four categories of ownership are given below for the years 1946 and 1947.

As is to be expected the smaller establishments, regardless of the type of products manufactured, are carried on under individual ownership. Industries carried on a small scale contain a large number of establishments in this category, the percentage decreasing as the scale of operations increase, as the following table shows:

It is therefore found according to table 1, that in the vegetable products group, 59 p.c. of the establishments were in the above category. Wood and paper products had 57.8 p.c. of its establishments in this classification followed by animal products with 38.1 p.c., miscellaneous industries 32.2 p.c., non-metallic mineral products 32.1 p.c., textiles and textile products 26 p.c., iron and its products 25.5 p.c., non-ferrous metal products 21.5 p.c. and chemicals and allied products 21 p.c.

The establishments operating under individual ownership are not as important from the point of view of employment provided as their large numbers would indicate. According to the tables 1 and 2, these establishments which comprised 46.4 p.c. of the total only had 7.5 p.c. of the total employees. Partnership accounted for 16.1 p.c. of the number of establishments and 4.5 p.c. of the total employees. Incorporated companies with 34.3 p.c. of the number of establishments had 87 p.c. of the employees. Co-operatives with 3.2 p.c. of the number had 1 p.c. of ths employees.

On the basic of employment provided, incorporated companies are by a very wide margin the most important factors in the employment field. In the chemicals and allied products group 96.8 p.c. of the employees were reported by such companies. Companies in the non-ferrous metals group has 96.6 p.c., iron and its products 96.1 p.c., non-metallic mineral products 92.6 p.c., miscellaneous industries 87.2 p.c., textiles 85.7 p.c., vegetable products 83.1 p.c., wood and paper products 78.7 p.c. and animal products 76.8 p.c. of the total employment.
