

EXPLANATORY NOTES

This report, appearing as a separate publication for the first time, was formerly published as Appendix II, "Alphabetical List of the Products Reported as having been Manufactured in Canada", in the "General Review of the Manufacturing Industries of Canada" (Catalogue No. 31-201). Publication as a separate report will, it is hoped, enhance its usefulness and permit its release in advance of the more comprehensive "General Review".

Scope of the Report

Several important qualifications with respect to content, coverage and arrangement of the items listed in the report should be noted by the user. Although most of the items listed are commodities, services performed by manufacturing establishments, such as repairs, dyeing, shrinking, etc., are also included. The object of including such service items is to conform with the "value of factory shipments" concept used in the Bureau's annual Census of Manufactures. This census, which applies to all establishments classified to the manufacturing industries (classes 101 to 399, inclusive, of the Bureau's Standard Industrial Classification¹), provides complete coverage of operational activities and collects, among other items, detailed data on value and, where applicable, quantities of goods of own manufacture shipped as well as services provided. Data for all commodities represent **quantities and values of goods of own manufacture shipped in 1961** regardless of whether manufactured in 1961 or earlier. Goods purchased for re-sale are specifically excluded from this report.

"Canadian manufacturers" as used in this report includes all of the establishments classified to the manufacturing industries mentioned above, i.e. those establishments whose principal activity is manufacturing, together with those establishments classified to other industries such as construction and wholesale trade whose principal activity is not manufacturing but which nevertheless engage in some manufacturing activity. This latter group of establishments was asked to complete a special "Commodity Schedule" listing details of products of own manufacture sold or shipped in 1961. The inclusion of products shipped by this group of establishments results, of course, in a greater value of factory shipments than that reported by the manufacturing industries *per se*. Another reason for the greater values of some products than originally published in various 1961 reports of the "Manufacturing Industries of Canada" series is the inclusion of products from two new industries (Poultry Processors and Dental Laboratories) and three new groups of establishments (book publishers in the Publishing Industry, electro-plating establishments in the Metal Stamping, Pressing and Coating Industry, and prescription branches in the Ophthalmic Goods Manufacturers Industry). These new industries and groups of establishments will be included in revised data on principal statistics for 1961 to be published in the relevant 1962 reports of the "Manufacturing Industries of Canada" series.

Arrangement and Identification of Items

Pending implementation of the Standard Commodity Classification in the annual Census of Manufactures, the arrangement of the items, as in previous years, is basically alphabetical. This

means that, in some cases, even using an alphabetic key, the commodities in the report are not directly comparable with those in DBS reports, "Imports by Commodities" and "Exports by Commodities", which are now based on the Standard Commodity Classification.

Although the arrangement of items is essentially alphabetical, certain exceptions have been made in the case of commodities in the clothing, electrical appliance (small), fabrics, food, furniture and machinery groups. Under "Clothing", for example, are listed in alphabetical order all major items of wearing apparel except footwear, gloves and mittens, headwear and hosiery, each of these four appearing in its appropriate place in the main listing. Within the clothing and other groups, major items (e.g. coats, dresses, suits, etc.) have been listed in alphabetical order, but subdivisions in many instances have been arranged, in conformity with industry or traditional usage, by such criteria as chief component material, method of fabrication, and sex and age group of the consumer. The basis for arrangement of such sub-groups should be readily apparent in most cases.

While every effort has been made to ensure complete coverage and unique identification of items included in the list, certain inherent limitations in the collection and presentation of the basic data should be noted. To avoid placing an undue reporting burden on respondents, the Bureau asks manufacturing establishments in each industry to report a specified list of products and to report separately any other large items not on the specified list. All other products shipped are reported in total only and are included in the "All other products, not specified" category following the alphabetical list of products in this report. It is obvious, therefore, that this "not specified" category may include items in the alphabetical list which were not considered of sufficient importance by individual establishments to be reported separately. It is impossible, of course, to estimate the effects of the non-allocation of "not specified" products to individual items although it is not considered serious enough to distort the value of the list for most purposes. In total, the value of such products was \$463.9 million, representing less than two per cent of the aggregate value of shipments.

In addition to those products not specified by the reporting establishment, there are a large number of items specified on individual returns but which cannot be published without substantially revealing particulars relating to one or more establishments. Such items are identified by footnote 1 and are included in total, by industry group, under the heading "Products for which data cannot be published" at the end of the list. In total, these amounted to \$873.9 million, of which the chemical and chemical products group accounted for \$293.0 million; food and beverages, \$120.4 million; and transportation equipment, \$106.9 million.

While efforts have been made to avoid duplication in the listing of products, it is possible that essentially the same commodity produced in different establishments has been reported under different names, especially when such items were not on the "specified products" list and were "written in" by the respondent. In such cases, the items would appear separately, or possibly in more detail than under another name, in the following list.
