STEEL INGOTS AND PIG IRON (Formerly Entitled "Steel Ingots")

Production of steel ingots in Canada during September, 1955, amounted to 367,550 net tons compared with 241,553 net tons in September, 1954.

Pig iron production was 276,533 net tons in September, 1955, compared with 156,373 net tons in the corresponding month of last year.
