

SPECIAL STATEMENT ON STEEL INGOT PRODUCTION

FEBRUARY, 1939.



Production of steel ingots in Canada amounted to 74,036 tons in February compared with 74,872 tons in the previous month and 95,025 tons in February of a year ago. This month's output was under the monthly average of 92,125 tons in 1938, 111,352 tons in 1937 and 90,129 tons in 1936.
