## MONTHLY REPORT

#### PRODUCTION OF IRON AND STEEL IN CANADA

#### APRIL, 1942

PIG IRON - Production of pig iron in Canada totalled 160,408 net tons compared with 167,116 tons in March of this year and with 115,725 tons in April, 1941. The average daily output in April was 5,347 tons against 5,390 tons in March. The total for the month under review included 135,160 tons of basic iron, 9,679 tons of foundry iron and 15,569 tons of malleable iron. Stocks of pig iron held by the producers at the end of April amounted to 35,578 tons.

FERRO-ALLOYS - Output of ferro-alloys in April amounted to 18,128 net tons compared with 20,261 tons in the previous month and with 18,100 tons in April of a year ago. The current month's total included the following alloys: ferrosilicon, silicomanganese, ferromanganese, ferrochrome, ferrochrome silicon, chrom-X, spiegeleisen, calcium silicon and ferrophosphorus

STEEL INGOTS AND CASTINGS - Production of steel ingots and direct steel castings during April totalled 264,988 net tons compared with 265,903 tons made in March of this year and with 224,761 tons made in April, 1941. Output in the month under review included 249.848 tons of ingots and 15,140 tons of castings. Steel furnaces operated at about 99 per cent of capacity during the month. The daily rate of output was 8,833 tons in April against 8,577 tons in March.
