MONTHLY REPORT

PRODUCTION OF IRON AND STEEL IN CANADA

FEBRUARY, 1945

PIG IRON - Production of pig iron in Canada amounted to 149,487 net tons in February compared with 141,878 tons in the corresponding month of last year. The total for the current month included 126,637 tons of basic iron, 9,403 tons of foundry iron and 13,447 tons of malleable iron.

FERRO-ALLOYS - Output of ferro-alloys in February amounted to 13,402 net tons compared with 12,130 tons in the previous month and with 14,720 tons in February of a year ago. The following alloys were produced; ferrosilicon, silicomanganese, ferromanganese, ferrochrome, chrom-x and ferrophosphorus.

STEEL INGOTS AND CASTINGS - Production of steel ingots and steel castings during February totalled 250,464 net tons compared with 229,852 tons in February of last year. Output in the month under review included 235,602 tons of ingots and 14,862 tons of castings.
