# MONTHLY REPORT

# PRODUCTION OF IRON AND STEEL IN CANADA

#### MARCH, 1945.

PIG IRON - Production of pig iron in Canada amounted to 165,517 net tons in March compared with 168,047 tons in the corresponding month of last year. The total for the current month included 134,325 tons of basic iron, 16,924 tons of foundry iron and 14,568 tons of malleable iron.

FERRO-ALLOYS - Output of ferro-alloys in March amounted to 16,434 net tons compared with 13,402 tons in the previous month and with 13,427 tons in March of a year ago. The following alloys were produced: ferrosilicon, silicomanganese, ferromanganese, ferrochrome, chromex and ferrophosphorus.

STEEL INGOTS AND CASTINCS - Production of steel ingots and steel castings during March totalled 277,461 net tons compared with 275,539 tons in March of last year. Output in the month under review included 261,524 tons of ingots and 15,937 tons of castings.
