PRODUCTION OF PIG IRON AND STEEL

Production of pig iron in Canada amounted to 272,187 net tons in April, 1955, compared with 194,307 tons in the corresponding month of last year. Production of steel ingots and steel castings during April totalled 360,754 net tons, compared with 255,796 tons in April of last year.
