## JANUARY, 1950

This report is the first of a new series covering monthly production and shipments of iron castings and cast iron pipes and fittings.

Total tonnage of iron castings of all kinds made during January amounted to 59,400, of which 37,700 tons were shipped.

Pig iron used by iron foundries during the month amounted to 32,900 tons while consumption of scrap iron and steel totalled 39,700 tons in the same period.






