Total tonnage of iron castings of all kinds made during January amounted to 66,100 tons, of which 41,200 tons were shipped and about 24,900 tons used in the producing plants.

Pig iron used by iron foundries during the month amounted to 30,700 tons, while consumption of scrap iron and steel totalled 45,200 tons in the same period.
