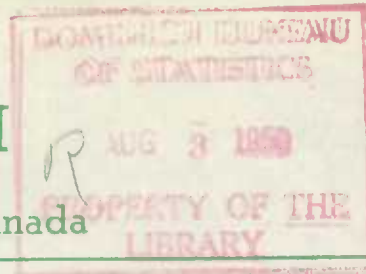

Producers' sales of stoves and furnaces in Canada were valued at \$4,484,185 in June, 1950. Electric ranges alone totalled 13,230 units worth \$1,877,066.

Producers' sales of warm air furnaces in June amounted to 6,689 units valued at \$877,549.
