Producers' sales of stoves and furnaces in Canada were valued at \$5,009,426 in March, 1953, compared with \$2,896,054 in March of last year. Electric ranges alone totalled 15,644, units valued at \$2,823,655 compared with 7,927 units worth \$1,294,692 in March, 1952.

Producers' cales of warm air furnaces totalled 4,205 units valued at \$807,091 in March, 1953, compared with 3,309 units at \$581,553 in the same month of last year.
