## STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 12,065 tons in October, 1955, compared with 9,927 tons in the corresponding month of 1954. This month's total included 8,335 tons of plain wire, 3,389 tons of galvanized wire, 168 tons of other coated wire, 97 tons of barbed wire and 76 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in Octo. r of last year, the amounts being 1,272 tons and 612 tons, respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were up to 9,295 tons from 7,713 tons in October, 1954.
