STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

JUNE, 1949

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,641 tons in June, 1949, compared with 8,572 tons in the corresponding month of 1948. This month's total included 5,479 tons of plain wire, 2,635 tons of galvanized wire, 223 tons of other coated wire, 1,094 tons of barbed wire and 210 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in June of last year, the amounts being 2,562 tons and 2,340 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were up slightly to 9,645 tons from 9,329 tons in June, 1948.




