## STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

JANUARY - 1950



Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,601 tons in January, 1950 compared with 11,086 tons in the corresponding month of 1949. This month's total included 5,793 tons of plain wire, 2,633 tons of galvanized wire, 152 tons of other coated wire, 826 tons of barbed wire and 197 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were lower than in January of last year, the amounts being 2,124 tons and 2,316 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were down to 6,399 tons from 8,890 tons in January, 1949.


