## STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

## NOVEMBER - 1951

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 11,105 tons in November, 1951, compared with 10,495 tons in the corresponding month of 1950. This month's total included 7,188 tons of plain wire, 2,840 tons of galvanized wire, 188 tons of other coated wire, 750 tons of barbed wire and 139 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in November of last year, the amounts being 1,162 tons and 754 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were up to 8,210 tons from 7,722 tons in November, 1950.
