## STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

NOVEMBER - 1952

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,542 tons in November, 1952 compared with 11,105 tons in the corresponding month of 1951. This month's total included 6,640 tons of plain wire, 2,541 tons of galvanized wire, 186 tons of other coated wire, 84 tons of barbed wire and 91 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were lower than in November of last year, the amounts being 849 tons and 1,162 tons respectively and the shipments of steel wire nails were down to 4,983 tons from 8,210 tons in November, 1951.
