## STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

## MARCH - 1952

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 10,547 tons in March, 1952 compared with 10,445 tons in the corresponding month of 1951. This month's total included 6,262 tons of plain wire, 2,714 tons of galvanized wire, 169 tons of other coated wire, 1,253 tons of barbed wire and 149 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were lower than in March of last year, the amounts being 2,327 tons and 2,562 tons respectively and the shipments of steel wire nails were up to 7,868 tons from 7,689 tons in March, 1951.
