OCTOBER - 1953

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,710 tons in October, 1953, compared with 11,810 tons in the corresponding month of 1952. This month's total included 6,761 tons of plain wire, 2,570 tons of galvanized wire, 113 tons of other coated wire, 111 tons of barbed wire and 155 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in October of last year, the amounts being 777 tons and 715 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were up to 7,558 tons from 7,104 tons in October of 1952.
