STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

NOVEMBER - 1953

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,665 tons in November, 1953, compared with 9,542 tons in the corresponding month of 1952. This month's total included 6,807 tons of plain wire, 2,543 tons of galvanized wire, 143 tons of other coated wire, 66 tons of barbed wire and 106 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in November of last year, the amounts being 932 tons and 849 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were up to 5,923 tons from 4,983 tons in November of 1952.
