STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

June - 1953

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 11,115 tons in June, 1953, compared with 10,913 tons in the corresponding month of 1952. This month's total included 8,203 tons of plain wire, 1,650 tons of galvanized wire, 173 tons of other coated wire, 942 tons of barbed wire and 147 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in June of last year, the amounts being 2,339 tons and 2,130 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were down to 6,685 tons from 7,577 tons in June of 1952.
