STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

JULY - 1953

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 8,884 tons in July, 1953, compared with 12,123 tons in the corresponding month of 1952. This month's total included 6,155 tons of plain wire, 1,868 tons of galvanized wire, 136 tons of other coated wire, 644 tons of barbed wire and 31 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in July of last year, the amounts being 1,567 tons and 1,550 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were down to 6,530 tons from 7,684 tons in July of 1952.
