## STEEL WIRE AND SPECIFIED WIRE PRODUCTS

Shipments of steel wire by Canadian producers amounted to 9,125 tons in April, 1954, compared with 11,045 tons in the corresponding month of 1953. This month's total included 5,598 tons of plain wire, 2,229 tons of galvanized wire, 90 tons of other coated wire, 1,101 tons of barbed wire and 107 tons of cold rolled flat wire.

Producers' shipments of wire fencing in the current month were higher than in April of last year, the amounts being 2,782 tons and 2,592 tons respectively, and the shipments of steel wire nails were up to 8,094 tons from 7,287 tons in April, 1953.
