THE BOILERS, TANKS AND ENGINES INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1928.

Production from the boilers, tanks and engines industry in Canada during 1928 was valued at \$6,507,437, an increase of 9 per cent over the total of \$5,945,694 for 1927, which in turn was 11 per cent greater than the value of \$5,343,208 reported for 1926. According to data compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, this output was the highest recorded since 1921 when production was valued at \$6,960,170.

Statistics for this industry cover the operations of all concerns which made boilers, tanks or engines as their principal product; but do not include the production data for other industries that built boilers, tanks or engines as a minor line. Such concerns are classified in other industrial groups according to the nature of their main product. Bata in this bulletin, therefore, should be read in conjunction with the rest of the series on "Iron and Steel and Their Products."

Thirty-five concerns reported in this group in 1928, there being 19 in Ontario, 8 in British Columbia, 4 in Nova Scotia and 4 in Quebec. These establishments reported fixed and working capital at \$\infty\$,352,068, afforded employment to a monthly average of 1,752 people and paid out \$\infty\$2,393,300 in salaries and wages during the year. Payments for purchased materials amounted to \$3,223,497 and the value added by manufacturing processes was \$3,278,940.

Among the commodities produced in this industry in 1928 were: 536 power boilers rated at 42,455 h.p. and valued at \$927,285; 350 heating boilers with a total rating of 21,090 h.p. worth \$362,971; 3,002 engines of all kinds with an aggregate rating of 19,491 h.p. valued at \$747,060; 6,130.storage and pressure tanks at \$512,549; heating and ventilating equipment, \$375,733; pulverized fuel equipment, \$198,280; mining and metallurgical machinery, \$175,799; pumps, \$109,691; and many other lines including safes, vaults and fittings; hydraulic turbines and water wheels; galvanized range boilers; structural steel; boats, smakestacks and smoke breeching; castings, etc. Table 1. - PRINCIPAL STATISTICS THE BOILERS, TANKS AND ENGINES INDUSTRY IN CANADA.




