IRON AND STEEL AND THEIR PRODUCTS

THE BRIDGE AND STRUCTURAL STEEL INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1930.

Value of work done in the Bridge and Structural Steel Industry in Canada amounted to \$26,055,783 in 1930. This industry includes the concerns which were engaged chiefly in fabricating and erecting structural steel for bridges, buildings, etc., and in 1930 covered the operations of 13 plants. Of these establishments, 8 were in Ontario, 2 in Quebec, 1 in Manitoba, 1 in Alberta, and 1 in British Columbia. These plants reported fixed and working capital of \$25,922,931 and employed a monthly average of 4,943 workers who received \$3,686,062 in salaries and wages during the year. Purchased materials cost \$12,549,435 and the value added by manufacturing processes was \$13,506,348.

Among the principal products were: bridges, 26,660 tens at \$4,086,221; structural work (buildings, transmission towers, etc.), 124,146 tens at \$14,775,652; plate and tank work, 4,610 tens at \$604,933; mechanical work (cranes, trolleys; car unleaders, etc.), 10,391 tens at \$2,517,313, and other lines of less value such as orwanental iron, etc., and sales of plain material.

Beginning with 1930, for statistical purposes the Bridge Building and Structural Steel Industry has been included in the general group of Iron and Steel and Their Products and now is treated as one of the individual industries within that larger group. Prior to 1930 it as classed under the "Construction" group and was not included in the reviews of the iron and steel manufactures.
